

11.3 Handball (Saturday and Sunday)

Handball is played on Saturday (09:00-17:00) in the Deppenbroekhal and on Sunday (09:00-15:00) in the Diekmanhalls.

1. A maximum of one men's and one women's team can be enrolled per OSSO/education institution. A team consists of a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 14 persons.
2. The team of an OSSO may only consist of students who meet the conditions as stipulated in chapter 1 of the event regulations of the SSN. If this rule is violated, all the team's results will be removed.
3. If an unauthorized participant participates in the GNSK, a fine of €200,- will be charged to the OSSO for which that participant competes. Also, the results of the team in question will be removed.
4. The team assignments must be submitted to the committee before the first game of the team.
5. The teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the tournament schedule. If this is not the case, the result is 5-0 in favour of the team present.
6. The poule division is based on a draw.
7. The duration of a match is set at 28 minutes continuous playing time without changing of the half of the game and without a break. The final will be two times 25 minutes, with a rest between the halves of 5 minutes and there will be a change of side. Players can be changed without restriction.
8. In case of a winning match, a team gets 2 points, in case of a draw a team gets 1 point. In the case of a tie in the pool, the mutual result between the relevant teams counts. Subsequently, the goal balance and number of scored goals will be decisive. If no decision has been reached yet, 7-metre throws will follow.
9. In the pool, a draw is possible. If a game ends in a draw in the final round of the tournament, the game will be extended by 2 x 5 minutes. If there is no winner, five 7-metre throws will follow. If necessary, a 7-metre throw will be taken in turns until a decision has been made.
10. Teams must wear shirts with shirt numbers. If necessary, the team that is mentioned second on the tournament schedule has to wear spare shirts.
11. Match balls are provided, practice balls must be taken by the team.
12. The use of resin is not allowed.
13. Protests will not be accepted as far as these concern referee decisions.
14. When no exception is made in the above points, the NHV regulations in force at that time apply, with the exception of the time stop rule for 7-metre throws and the time-out rule.
15. In all cases, the Committee has the right to make a binding decision.
