

12.5 Squash (Saturday and Sunday)

Squash will be played on Saturday (10:00-17:00) and Sunday (10:00-15:00) in the Twentehallen.

1. A maximum of one mixed team can be enrolled per OSSO/educational institution. A team consists of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 players of which at least two are ladies and two are men.
2. The team of an OSSO may only consist of students who meet the conditions set out in chapter 1 of the event's regulations of the SSN. If this rule is violated, the team loses all matches.
3. If an unauthorized participant participates in the GNSK, a fine of €200,- will be charged to the OSSO for which that participant competes. Also, the results of the team in question will be cancelled.
4. Teams must report to the Squash committee and tell the line-up 15 minutes before the start of the match. In case of late attendance (at the discretion of the squash committee), the party present will have won all matches against the city in question 5-0.
5. Per team game is played: 1 ladies single, 1 men single, 1 ladies double, 1 men double, 1 mixed double.
6. The pool classification is based on a drawing of lots.
7. The maximum warming up time is 5 minutes.
8. Until the finals shortened games will be played (2 sets, starting each set with the score 0-0). With a score of 1-1 in sets, 1 super tiebreak is played to decide who has won the game. The result will then be such that the winner has played a third set and won 7-6.
9. The finals consist of regular matches (2 sets won).
10. The games for 3rd and 4th place are also played according to the regular rules (2 sets won).
11. For each pool we look at the team that has won the most matches. In deviation, the team that has won all team games ends first.
12. In the event of a tie, the balance of wins and losses is taken into account. If it is also a tie, the balance of won and lost sets will be taken into account. If it is also a tie, the number of games won and lost is taken into account. If this is also equal, the results between the concerned teams will be looked at.
13. Participants should bring shoes that are suitable for playing tennis. This year there will be played on hardcourt (artificial grass shoes may also be used).
14. As far as no exception is made in the above points, the regulations of the KNLTB are in place.
15. In all cases, the Squash committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
