

12.8 Volleyball (Friday, Saturday and Sunday)

Volleyball is played on Friday between 18:00 and 21:00, on Saturday between 09:00 and 18:00 and on Sunday between 09:00 and 15:00, all in the University Sports Centre at the University of Twente.

Team composition and playing eligibility

1. A maximum of one men's and one women's team can be registered per Umbrella Student Sport Organisation (hereafter: OSSO)/educational institution. A team consists of:
 - a. A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 14 players
2. An OSSO's team may only consist of students who meet the conditions set out in chapter 1 of the SSN's events regulations. If this rule is violated, all results of the team in question will be cancelled.
3. If an unauthorized participant participates in the SUSA GNSK, a fine of €200,- will be charged to the OSSO for which that participant is eligible. The results of the team in question will also be cancelled.
4. The team assignment must take place before the first game of the team.

Competition rules

5. Nevobo's "Rules 2019-2020 - Eredivisie and Top Division" apply to this tournament.
6. Match shirts must be numbered according to Nevobo rules. The same applies to the color scheme of the Libero shirt.
7. The first mentioned team in the tournament schedule is the home team.
8. Counters will be arranged as much as possible by the organization. In the unlikely event that no counter is present, the home team is responsible for arranging replacement counters.
9. The home team shall deliver an approved match ball which is in good condition.
10. Each team shall bring its own balls for the purpose of warming-up.
11. Before a match teams have 10 minutes to warm up near the net. Where possible, use is made of the areas at the top of the stands for the warm-up without a ball.
12. The use of set-up notes is obligatory.
13. Teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the tournament schedule. If the team is not present at the specified time, the team loses the game. The result is 3-0 in the final and 2-0 in all other rounds, with set results 25-0 in favor of the team present.

Pool phase

14. The pool classification is based on drawing of lots.
15. The pool phase is played with matches according to a "best of three" system, with a possible third set being played according to the rules that apply to a regular fifth set.
16. A match won 2-0 is worth 3 match points, a match won 2-1 scores 2 points for the winning team and 1 point for the losing team.
17. The result during the pool phase will be determined based on the number of match points a team has won.
18. In case of an equal number of match points in a pool, it is decided successively:
 - a. the quotient of the number of sets for and against in all games played;
 - b. the quotient of the number of points scored for and against in all matches played;
 - c. the number of competition points in the mutual match (matches, in case of a tie between several teams);
 - d. the quotient of the number of sets for and against in the mutual match (matches, in case of a tie between several teams);
 - e. the quotient of the number of points obtained for and against in the mutual matches, in case of a tie between several teams;
 - f. If the result is still tied, a deciding set is played, in accordance with the rules of the game

that apply to a fifth set.

Cross-finals

19. The semi-finals are also played according to a "best of three" system, with a possible third set being played according to the rules that apply to a regular fifth set.
20. The finals are played according to a "best of five" system.

Last provisions

21. Protests concerning arbitration decisions are not possible.
22. In case of disputes, the volleyball committee will decide, following the rules, guidelines and procedures of Nevobo as they apply to the honorary and top divisions, as much as possible unless they conflict with the provisions of this document.
23. In all cases, the volleyball committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
