Timetable

On Friday, matches start at 5.30pm, on Saturday at 9am and on Sunday at 10am. One hour before the matches start, the Topsportcentrum will be open and the futsal committee will be present. Between 12.30 and 2pm, each team can have lunch (facilitated by the GNSK organisation), with the match programme continuing. The final matches on Saturday are scheduled at 6pm and on Sunday at 2pm. The award ceremony of futsal of the women's tournament will take place on Saturday around 4pm at the Topsportcentrum and of the men's tournament on Sunday around 3pm. The award ceremony of the city ranking will take place on Sunday around 5pm in the Sports Café at the Erasmus Sports Building.

Match schedules

The match schedules can be found in the GNSK 2024 app in the section match schedules. Instructions and explanations about the app can be found below.

In the men's tournament, games are played in two groups of four teams, with the top two in each group advancing to the semi-finals. The final matches are then played for the gold and bronze medals. The numbers 3 in both groups will play a match for the 5th spot against each other and the numbers 4 in both groups will play a match for the 7th spot.

In the women's tournament, they will play in 1 group of 3 teams, playing both a home and away match. On Friday evening, each women's team will play 2 matches and again 2 matches on Saturday. Medals will be distributed based on the final ranking in the group.

Futsal related issues

It is important to read through the regulations (*see at the very end of this playbook*) for all participants and team officials.

During the tournament, the regular KNVB rules will be followed (district rules). The main exceptions/attention points:

- Matches last 2x 20 minutes with 5 minutes rest (as long as the matches are on schedule).
- In the event of a draw in the knock-out phase, there will first be 2x 5-minute extensions, followed by penalty kicks.

- Shirts with back numbers are compulsory. If necessary, the away team must provide a spare jersey. Vests will be provided if the away team does not have one.
- Lunch for the home team must be collected by the team captain from the car park in front of the Topsportcentrum at 12.30pm.

Qualification European Universities Championships

The winners of the 2024 GNSK futsal tournament will qualify for the 2025 European Universities Championships (EUC). These will be organised from 23 to 31 July in Zagreb, Croatia.

Competition venue

Futsal is played at the Topsportcentrum Rotterdam, next to the car park of stadium de Kuip. The address is: Van Zandvlietplein 20, 3077 AA Rotterdam.

Before sports can be played at the competition venue, registration is required at the registration desk in the Erasmus Sports Building or the Topsportcentrum (*see below for more information*).

The competition committee will be present on all three days, at the competition desk of the main venue. This is in Topsporthal 1 on Friday and in Breedtesporthal 2 on Saturday and Sunday.

In the Topsportcentrum Rotterdam, futsal is played in 3 different halls, namely Topsporthal 1, Breedtesporthal 1 and Breedtesporthal 2.

Signage is available in the Topsportcentrum, to be on the safe side, below is a brief description of how to get to each hall:

Topsporthal 1:

Upon entering, walk straight ahead. To the right of the very first staircase is Topsporthal 1. In the first corridor to the right just before this door are the changing rooms.

Breedtesporthal 1:

Upon entering, walk straight ahead and turn left. Walk past the café towards the lifts. Walk past the lifts and take the left stairs up. To the left after the stairs is Breedtesporthal 1. To the right after the stairs is a door to the corridor with the changing rooms and lockers.

Breedtesporthal 2:

Upon entering, walk straight ahead and turn left. Walk past the café towards the lifts and take the lift to Breedtesporthal 2. The lifts lead directly into Breedtesporthal 2. The changing rooms are on the right. Unfortunately, it is not possible to reach Breedtesporthal 2 by stairs.

Changing rooms and equipment

On Friday and Saturday, 3 men's changing rooms and 1 women's changing room are available (2 changing rooms per hall, see match schedule for the correct halls). On Sundays, two men's changing rooms are available. It will be clearly indicated on the doors of the changing rooms which ones can be used for the GNSK. As several teams have to use the same changing rooms, it is requested not to leave belongings in the changing rooms. Everyone can take his/her belongings to the hall and/or there are free lockers available where (valuable) items can be stored. The lockers can be found at Breedtesporthal 1 and Breedtesporthal 2.

Use of changing rooms not intended for the GNSK will result in a fine.

Refreshments

The Topsportcentrum is strict about consuming your own refreshments. If you bring your own snack, this is no problem. For refreshments other than those organised by the GNSK organisation, participants can make use of Sportcafé The Final on the ground floor of the Topsportcentrum.

Public transport

Tram to Stadion Feyenoord stop (line 23 or 125) or bus to Stadionweg stop (line 75)

Car

You can park your car for free at P2 in front of the Topsportcentrum Rotterdam.

Registration GNSK 2024

Signing up and registering for the GNSK 2024 must be done before participating in the sports tournament. This can be done on Friday and Saturday at the registration desk in the Erasmus Sports Building or at the registration desk in the Topsportcentrum. The address of the Erasmus Sports Building is: Burgemeester Oudlaan 50, 3062 PA Rotterdam.

You can sign in at the following times at the Erasmus Sports Building:

- Friday 7 June: 3pm to 8pm
- Saturday 8 June: 8am to 1pm

You can sign in at the following times at the Topsportcentrum:

- Friday 7 June: 5pm to 7pm
- Saturday 8 June: 8.30am to 12pm

You must be able to provide the following documents before applying:

- Valid certificate of registration from the educational institution, or certificate of graduation after 1 January 2023 (*only required for participants, not for team officials*)
- Valid accreditation card on the GNSK 2024 app (*see below GNSK 2024 app*)
- Valid passport, ID card or driving license

After this is done, participants and team officials can go to the competition venue with a valid accreditation.

Transport to Erasmus Sports Building

At the Erasmus Sports Building several sports tournaments will be organised, breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served and all participants and team officials should sign in and register here. The address is: Burgemeester Oudlaan 50, 3062 PA Rotterdam.

Public transport

Erasmus Sport is very easy to reach by bicycle or public transport. If you come to Rotterdam by train, there are 3 ways to get to Erasmus Sport from Rotterdam Central Station:

- Public transport bike rental at Central Station
- Metro to stop Kralingse Zoom (take line D towards De Akkers or line E towards Slinge and change at stop Beurs to line A towards Binnenhof, line B towards Nesselande or line C towards De Terp)
- Tram to Burgemeester Oudlaan stop (line 7 towards Woudestein) or Oude Plantage stop (line 21 or 24 towards De Esch)

Car

If you come by car, you can park in the Erasmus University car park. Exit 7 is the quickest way to the Erasmus Sports Building.

An exit ticket for the car park costs €5 and can be obtained from the Erasmus Sports service desk. The exit ticket entitles you to a single exit and is therefore independent of how long you have parked. Without an exit ticket, parking is free for up to 19 minutes, after that the parking fee is €1.50 per hour and must be paid at the ticket machine before you can exit.

GNSK 2024 app

Once again this year there is the GNSK app containing all information about the GNSK, such as first aid, party and competition programmes. Importantly, the app is used for accreditation during the GNSK and every participant and team official must download this app. In the following steps, you can download the app and request your personal accreditation:

Step 2: Open the GNSK app and click on the three bars in the top left corner

Step 3: Click on 'accreditation card'

Step 4: Enter your phone number

Step 5: Enter the verification code you receive in a SMS

Catering

All meals at the GNSK 2024 are vegetarian.

Breakfast

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings is open only to participants, team officials and volunteers who use the campsite with breakfast. The breakfast buffet will be facilitated in the Hatta building (opposite the Erasmus Sports Building). A person can walk past the breakfast buffet a maximum of 1 time and everyone should clean up his/her leftovers and waste neatly. Breakfast lasts from 7 to 9 am and shifts will be announced during the weekend.

Breakfast consists of bread with toppings (butter, hummus, cheese, chocolate spread, peanut butter) and fruit.

Lunch

Lunch will be delivered on Saturday and Sunday afternoon for all participants, team officials and volunteers active in the tournament on this day. Lunch will be delivered per team in 1 lunch box at the Topsportcentrum at 12.30pm. Due to strict agreements regarding the consumption of own refreshments, the team captain must collect the lunch box for his/her own team at this time at the car park of the Topsportcentrum and take it to the stand in Topsportthal 1 where the whole team can have lunch. The match programme will continue unabated during lunch, so if a team plays during the delivery of lunch, the futsal committee will collect the lunch box.

It is very important that each participant and team dispose of all waste themselves in the designated bin and return any leftover food to the futsal committee.

Lunch consists of bread with toppings (butter, hummus, cheese, chocolate spread, peanut butter) and fruit.

Dinner

Dinner on Friday and Saturday evenings is open only to participants and team officials who have purchased it when registering. No dinner will be facilitated on Sunday. Dinner will be served in the Erasmus Sport Café and can then be eaten in the Hatta Building (opposite the Erasmus Sports Building). A person can walk past the buffet a maximum of 1 time and everyone should clean up his/her leftovers and waste neatly. Dinner will last from 5pm to 8pm and the shifts will be announced during the weekend.

The meal on Friday consists of veggie sausage with jacket potatoes, eggplant, paprika, courgette, onion and chickpeas, complemented by a delicious fresh salad with cucumber and tomato.

The meal on Saturday consists of well-filled spaghetti with eggplant, courgette, onion, paprika, broccoli, leek and tomato.

Campsite

The campsite is at the Rotterdam Student Football Association Antibarbari, a stone's throw from Erasmus Sport. The address is: Kralingse Zoom 100, 3063 NC Rotterdam.

There is only use of the campsite if this is indicated when registering for GNSK 2024. Participants who have done so will spend the night on a grassy field and should bring their own tent and sleeping gear for this purpose. It is important to bring a tent suitable for the number of people who will sleep in it. If you bring a tent that is too big for the number of people that will sleep in it, the organisation may refuse the tent.

When you arrive at the campsite for the first time, you will have to report to the volunteers at the entrance and show your accreditation in the GNSK app. You can do this on Friday between 2pm and midnight and on Saturday between 8am and 8pm. The volunteers will assign you a spot, so if you want to camp together, make sure you arrive at the same time.

Every next time you want to enter the campside, you will have to show your accreditation in the GNSK app to security. So make sure your phone is charged!

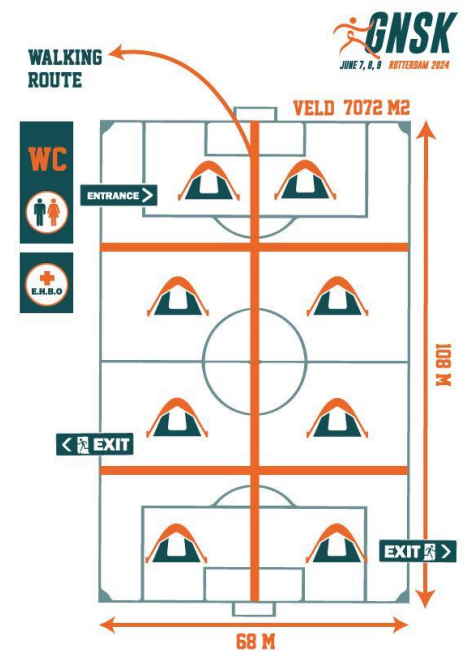
The campsite has toilets, drinking water and about 10 power points. So bring an extra battery or power bank to charge your phone overnight. Participants can shower at the sports venue of their sport.

Public transport

Tram to Nesserdijk stop (line 21 or 24 towards De Esch) or metro to Kralingse Zoom stop (line A, B or C + 10-minute walk).

Car

You can park your car temporarily (maximum 10 minutes) at the campsite for loading and unloading. To do so, use entrance RHV Leonidas (address: Toepad 95). After loading and unloading, you can park your car at Erasmus University (see above).



Opening ceremony

The opening ceremony starts on Friday 7 June at 7pm at the Erasmus Sports Building. All GNSK participants are welcome to attend. The programme is as follows:

- Start of the opening ceremony at 7pm
- Official opening at 7.30pm, including the OSSO award ceremony and the opening of the obstacle run
- Drinks from 20.00 to 22.00, with the opportunity to watch the beach volleyball matches and challenge the obstacle run

Party

This year's party will take place on Saturday 8th of June at the student association RSC/RVSV. The address is: Robert Baeldestraat 55, 3061 TH Rotterdam.

Participants, team officials, volunteers, supporters and other party enthusiasts can only gain access to the party if a ticket has been purchased in advance. This may have been done when registering for the GNSK 2024, or later via the Erasmus Sport webshop (see below for more information). There will be no ticket sales at the door.

From 20.00 you are welcome to join us for sparkling music, tasty drinks and a spacious dance floor to show off your moves. The music will be turned off at 01.00 and the last students will have to leave the party venue at 01.30 at the latest.

A ticket costs €10, with which you will receive a free drink (beer, wine or soft drink). The venue is easy to reach by bike and, if necessary, on foot.

Ticket sales via Erasmus Sport

Step 1: Go to <https://webshop.erasmusport.nl/>

Step 2: Click on 'Log in as new user' and enter your desired username and password

Step 3: Fill in your personal details

Step 4: Agree to the terms and conditions and click 'Sign up'

Step 5: Log in to your account and click on 'Courses'

Step 6: Click on 'GNSK Party' and then on 'Register'

Step 7: Mark the box with your own name, put your order 'In shopping cart' and complete the payment process

Protest Committee

During the tournament, a protest may be submitted to the protest committee of the GNSK organisation by the team captain (in the case of a team tournament) or by an individual participant (in the case of an individual tournament). The protest must be submitted within 1 hour after the end of the match.

Team captains or participants may file a protest against other participants/teams based on the participation right and competition rules. Decisions of referees or other officials cannot be challenged, nor can the rules of the GNSK, the rules of the campsite and other articles of the event regulations of Student Sport Netherlands.

To file a protest, the following steps must be fulfilled:

- The chairman of the sports committee must be informed of the protest as soon as possible after the end of the match in which the alleged offence took place.
- The protest must be sent in by e-mail to info@studentensport.nl. The mail must be complete and sent within one hour of the end of the match.
- The protest must be signed by an official representative of the team and must contain the following elements:
 - Date, time and location of the incident
 - The relevant article that has been breached
 - A description of the situation
 - The name(s) of the protesting team/participants, signed

On Saturday, protests will be dealt with no later than the end of the day. On Sunday, protests will be dealt with as soon as possible, but no later than two hours after the protest is submitted. All protests must be settled before the start of the finals.

Match regulations (EN and NL)

Wedstrijdreglement Zaalvoetbal

GNSK 2024

Teamsamenstelling en speelgerechtigdheid

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (hierna: OSSO)/stad kunnen meerdere heren- en damesteams ingeschreven worden. Een team bestaat uit minimaal 6 en maximaal 12 spelers. Het eerste ingeschreven team per OSSO/stad heeft altijd recht om mee te doen. Afhankelijk van het aantal ingeschreven teams wordt besloten of de andere teams mee kunnen doen. Mochten er te veel teams zijn voor de overgebleven plekken, gaat deelname op basis van volgorde van inschrijving.
2. De ingeschreven deelnemers van een OSSO/stad mogen uitsluitend bestaan uit studenten die voldoen aan de voorwaarden als gesteld in hoofdstuk 1 van het evenementenreglement van SSN. Bij overtreding van deze regel verliest het team alle wedstrijden. Als er een ongerechtigde deelnemer meedoet aan het GNSK, wordt er een boete van €200,- in rekening gebracht bij de OSSO/vertegenwoordigende organisatie in de stad voor welke die deelnemer uitkomt.
3. De teamopstelling dient voor aanvang van de eerste wedstrijd doorgegeven te worden aan de zaalvoetbalcommissie. Mocht een OSSO/stad twee deelnemende teams sturen, dan mogen er geen spelers gewisseld worden of bij het andere team meespelen. Mocht dit wel gebeuren, dan geldt artikel 2.
4. De winnaar van het zaalvoetbaltoernooi van het GNSK 2024 kwalificeert zich voor de European Universities Championships (EUC) van 23 t/m 31 juli 2025 in Zagreb (Kroatië).

Wedstrijdbepalingen

5. De voorrondes bestaan uit poules. De poule-indeling geschiedt op basis van loting, waarbij teams geplaatst worden volgens de Uitvoeringsregeling Plaatsing GNSK 2024 en indien mogelijk teams van eenzelfde OSSO/stad worden verdeeld over verschillende poules. De zaalvoetbalcommissie beslist voor de loting hoeveel teams per poule zich kwalificeren voor het finaleschema dat door middel van een knock-outsysteem wordt gespeeld.
6. Bij een gewonnen wedstrijd krijgt een team 3 punten, bij een gelijkspel 1. De eindstand van de poule wordt bepaald op basis van het aantal punten dat een team behaald heeft. Bij een gelijke stand in de poule beslist achtereenvolgens het onderlinge resultaat, het doelsaldo en het aantal doelpunten voor. Als er nog geen beslissing is bereikt, nemen 5 spelers van ieder team elk één strafschop. Indien hierna nog geen beslissing valt wordt de strafschoppenserie voortgezet, totdat een team een doelpunt meer heeft gemaakt dan de andere partij, nadat elke partij een gelijk aantal strafschoppen heeft genomen. Per serie strafschoppen mag de doelman niet vervangen worden, tenzij deze geblesseerd is geraakt.
7. De wedstrijden duren 2x 20 minuten met 5 minuten rust en 5 minuten inspeeltijd. De zaalvoetbalcommissie kan de tijd aanpassen naar 2x 15 of 2x 25 minuten wanneer zij dit nodig acht.
8. Indien in de knock-outfase een wedstrijd in een gelijkspel eindigt, wordt deze verlengd met 2x 5 minuten. Indien nodig, gaat men over tot het nemen van strafschoppen (op dezelfde manier als in artikel 6 is opgenomen).

9. Er mag tijdens de wedstrijden constant door gewisseld worden. Spelers mogen dus meerdere keren in- en uitgewisseld worden. Er mag gewisseld worden als de bal buiten het spel is, maar ook als de bal in het spel is. Let op: de speler moet eerst buiten het veld zijn voordat de invaller in het veld komt, anders wordt een vrije bal aan de tegenpartij gegeven.

10. Als een speler een gele kaart ontvangt, krijgt hij/zij een tijdsraf opgelegd en moet hij/zij het veld verlaten voor twee minuten. Bij een doelpunt van de tegenstander binnen deze twee minuten mag de speler er direct weer in.

11. Als een speler een rode kaart (of twee gele) ontvangt, moet hij/zij het veld verlaten en is hij/zij geschorst voor de volgende wedstrijd. Na 5 minuten mag een andere speler het veld betreden, zodat het weer 5 tegen 5 is. Bij een doelpunt van de tegenstander binnen deze vijf minuten mag de vervangende speler er direct in.

12. De teams dienen op het in het wedstrijschema aangegeven tijdstip aanwezig en speelklaar te zijn. Indien het team niet aanwezig is op het opgegeven tijdstip, dan verliest het team de wedstrijd. De uitslag is dan 3-0 in het voordeel van het aanwezige team.

13. De teams dienen shirts met rugnummers te dragen. Zo nodig dient de ploeg die als tweede op het wedstrijschema wordt genoemd voor reserveshirts te zorgen.

14. Er wordt gespeeld met officieel goedgekeurde wedstrijdballen. De wedstrijdballen worden verstrekt door de zaalvoetbalcommissie. De oefenballen dienen zelf meegenomen te worden.

15. Protesten worden niet geaccepteerd voor zover deze scheidsrechterlijke beslissingen betreffen.

Slotbepalingen

16. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor ongevallen of schade aan derden vóór, tijdens of na de wedstrijd. Deelname geschiedt op eigen risico.

17. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor diefstal vóór, tijdens of na de competitie.

18. Voor zover in bovenstaande punten geen uitzondering wordt gemaakt, zijn de [reglementen van de KNVB](#) van kracht.

19. In alle gevallen behoudt de zaalvoetbalcommissie zich het recht voor om een bindende beslissing te nemen.

Regulations Futsal

GNSK 2024

Team composition and eligibility

1. Each Student Sport Council (OSSO) or city can register multiple men's and women's teams. A team consists of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12 players. The first team registered per OSSO or city always has the right to participate. Depending on the number of registered teams, a decision will be made regarding the participation of the other teams. If there are too many other teams for the remaining spots, participation will be based on the order of registration.

2. The registered participants from an OSSO or city may only consist of students who meet the requirements as set in Chapter 1 of the SSN event regulations. In case of a violation of this rule, the team will forfeit all matches. If an ineligible participant takes part in the GNSK, a fine of €200 will be charged to the OSSO or representative organization in the city to which the participant belongs.

3. The team lineup must be provided to the futsal committee before the start of the first match. If an OSSO or city sends more participating teams, players cannot be swapped or participate in other teams. If this happens, Article 2 applies.

4. The winner of the futsal tournament of the GNSK 2024 qualifies for the European Universities Championships (EUC) from July 23 to July 31, 2025, in Zagreb (Croatia).

Match provisions

5. The preliminary rounds of the team tournament consist of groups. The group placement is determined by drawing, with teams seeded according to Implementation Regulation Seeding GNSK 2024 and, if possible, teams from the same OSSO or city distributed across different groups. The futsal committee decides, prior to the draw, how many teams per group qualify for the final bracket, which is played through a knockout system.

6. In case of a won match, a team receives 3 points, and in case of a draw, 1 point. The final ranking in the group is determined by the total number of points a team has earned. In the event of a tie in the group stage, the ranking is decided successively by the head-to-head result, the goal difference and the number of goals scored. If no decision is reached, five different players from each team take one penalty each. If necessary, both teams will then take turns with penalties until a decision is reached. In a penalty shootout series, the goalkeeper may not be substituted unless injured.

7. The matches last two times 20 minutes with a 5-minute break. Teams will switch halves during the break. Teams have 5 minutes warm-up time before the match starts. The futsal committee can adjust the time to two times 15 or two times 25 minutes if deemed necessary.

8. If a match in the knockout bracket ends in a draw, it is extended by two times 5 minutes. If necessary, penalty kicks are taken (in the same manner as described in article 6).

9. Players can be substituted constantly during the matches. Players can be substituted in and out multiple times. Substitutions can occur when the ball is out of play or in play. It's important to note that the player must be outside the field before the substitute enters; otherwise, a free kick will be awarded to the opposing team.

10. If a player receives a yellow card, he/she is given a time penalty and must leave the field for two minutes. If the opposing team scores within these two minutes, the player can re-enter immediately.

11. If a player receives a red card (or a second yellow), he/she must leave the field and is suspended for the next match. After 5 minutes, another player can enter the field, restoring it to a 5 versus 5 situation. If the opposing team scores within these five minutes, the substitute player can enter immediately.

12. Teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the schedule. If a team is not present at the specified time, the team loses the match. The score will be recorded as 3-0 in favor of the present team.

13. The teams must wear shirts with numbers. If necessary, the team mentioned second on the match schedule is responsible for providing reserve shirts.

14. Officially approved match balls will be used. The match balls will be provided by the futsal committee. Practice balls should be brought by the teams themselves.

15. Protests will not be accepted as far as they concern referee decisions.

Closing provisions

16. Players must wear appropriate sports attire and shoes. The matches will be played on clay courts, however the tennis committee may deviate from this if deemed necessary.

17. The organization is not responsible for accidents or damage to third parties before, during, or after the match. Participation is at your own risk.

18. In the absence of exceptions in the above points, the [regulations of the KNVB](#) are in force.

19. In all cases, the futsal committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
