Timetable

Matches will be played at the RSC starting at 4:00 p.m. on Friday. All teams will have at least 1 game on Friday. The last matches will be over around 9:30 p.m., leaving plenty of time to get ready for a party. (See @nsbv_trajanum on instagram for info)

On Saturdays we play at De Triangel in Lent. Here the matches start at 9:00 and we play until 17:30. At the end of the afternoon we switch from the pool phase to the first rounds of knockout. It is possible that as a team you will play your last match on Saturday.

On Sunday we play again in The Triangle and again the matches start at 9:00. On Sunday most of the knockout phase will be played, concluding with the women's and men's finals at 14:30 and 15:30 respectively.

Match schedules

The match schedules can be found in the GNSK 2025 app in the section match schedules. Instructions and explanations about the app can be found below.

The group stage of the men's team tournament will be played in 3 pools of 4/5 teams. We then move to a knockout schedule of 16 teams, with a buy in for the 2 best 1st places (based on goal difference). The group stage of the women's team tournament will be played in 2 pools of 4/5 teams.



Then we move to a knockout schedule with 8 teams, with spot 8 being given to the team with higher goal difference that is in last place.

Basketball related issues

It is important to read through the regulations (*see at the very end of this playbook*) for all participants and team officials.

The woman's tournament will be played with a size 6 ball. The men's tournament will be played with a size 7 ball.

Qualification European Universities Championships

The winners of the GNSK 2025 Badminton team tournament will qualify for the 2026 European Universities Championships (EUC).

Basketball is played on Friday at the Radboud Sportcentrum in hal 1A&B.

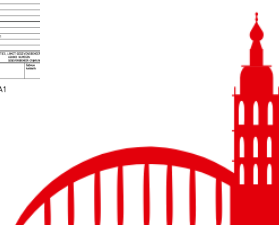
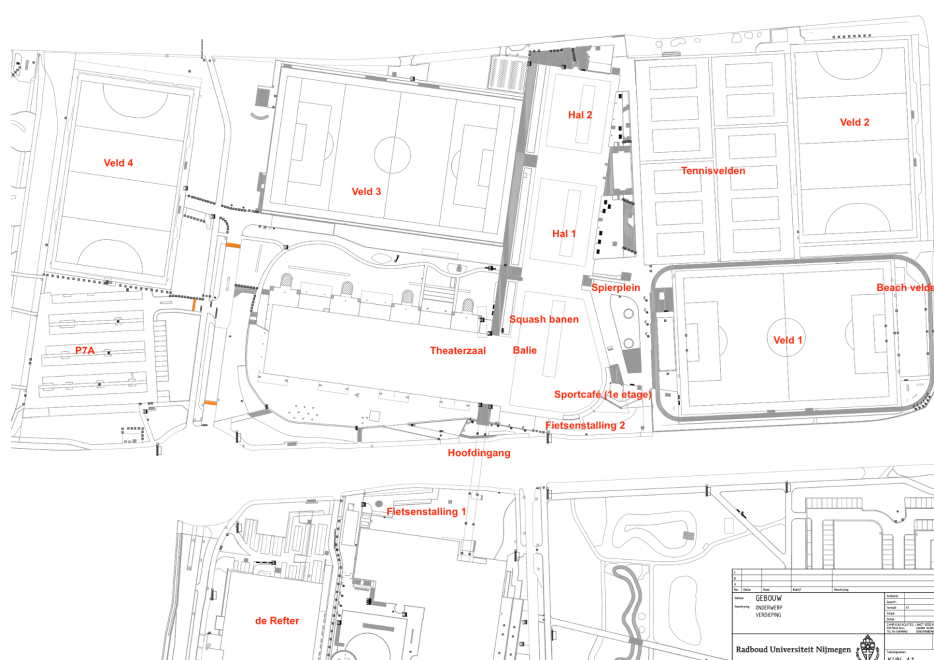

Basketball will be played on Saturday and Sunday at De Triangel. The Address is: **Griftdijk Noord 9B, 6663 AA Nijmegen**

Shuttle bus:

- The shuttle runs Saturday in the morning at 7:30 AM, 8:20 AM and 9:10 AM to the location and returns in the afternoon at 18:20 PM, 19:10 PM and 20:00 PM to the Radboud Sports Centre.
- The shuttle runs Sunday in the morning at 7:30 AM, 8:20 AM and 9:10 AM to the location and returns in the afternoon at 17:00 PM, 17:50 PM, 18:40 PM to the Radboud Sports Centre.

Walking: Approximately 1 hour and 23 minutes from the Radboud Sports Centre.

Cycling: Approximately 24 minutes from the Radboud Sports Centre.

Before participating in any matches at the competition venue, registration is required at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum (see below for more information).

In hall 1A&B of the Radboud Sportcentrum, matches will be played on 2 courts. In the Triangel, matches will be played on 3 courts.

Registration GNSK 2024

Signing up and registration for the GNSK 2025 must be done before participating in the sports tournament. This can be done on Friday in sporthal IC and on Saturday at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum. The address is: **Heyendaalseweg 141, 6525 AJ Nijmegen.**

You must be able to provide the following documents before applying:

- Valid certificate of registration from the educational institution, or certificate of graduation (*Only required for participants, not for team officials*)
- Valid accreditation card on the GNSK 2025 app (*see below GNSK 2025 app*)
- Valid passport, ID card or driving license

After this is done, participants and team officials can go to the competition venue with a valid accreditation.



Transport to Radboud Sportcentrum

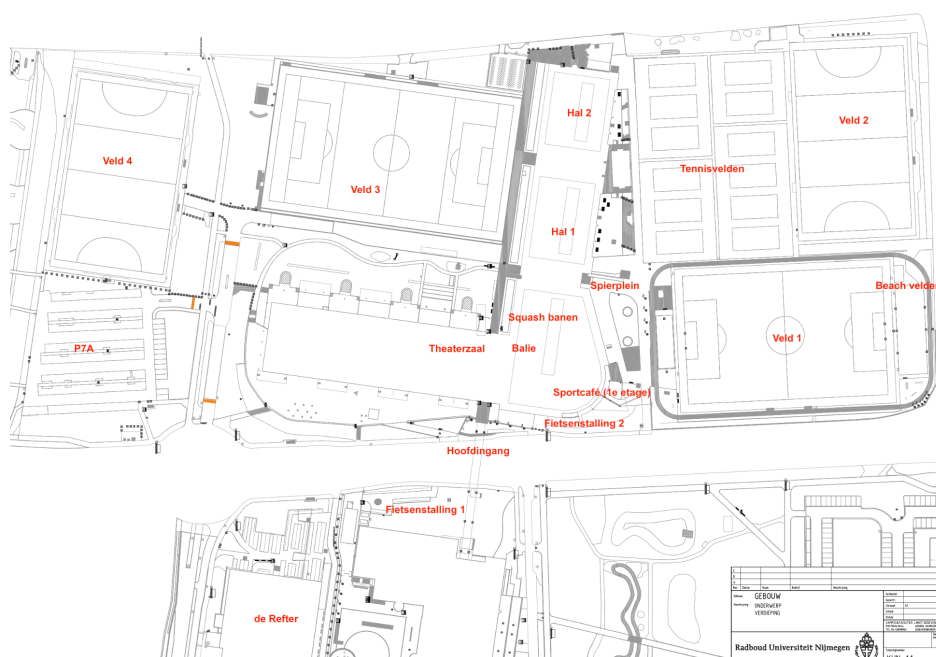

Map Radboud Sportcentrum

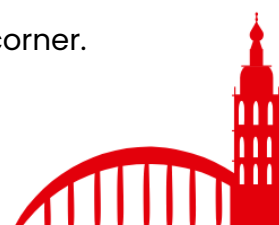


GNSK 2025 app

Catering

Breakfast

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with breakfast. The breakfast buffet is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Breakfast is served from 6:30 to 9:00 AM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

The breakfast includes:

- Bread: Whole wheat bread / White bread
- Toppings: Cheese / Chicken breast / Strawberry jam / Chocolate sprinkles / Boiled egg
- Other: Mini donut / Hangop (strained yogurt) / Muesli / Fruit
- Drinks: Coffee / Tea / Orange juice

Lunch

During the weekend, participants and team officials are responsible for arranging their own lunch. Various food stalls will be available at the Radboud Sports Centre, and you can also visit *The Yard*, the sports café located inside the centre.

Dinner

Dinner on Friday and Saturday is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with dinner. Dinner is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Dinner is served from 5:00 to 8:00 PM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

Meals are served vegetarian by default. Please indicate any dietary requirements when registering.

Campsite

Accommodation is provided at the Radboud Sportcentrum in the sports halls and at a campsite located at Sportpark D'Almarasweg.

Sleeping facilities are only available to those who indicated this during their registration for GNSK 2025. Participants will either sleep in the indoor sports halls or camp on a grass field using their own tents.

Those staying in the sports halls must bring their own sleeping gear (including mat or air mattress, blanket, and pillow).

Those camping outdoors must bring their own tents and full sleeping equipment. It's important to bring a tent appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents for too few people may be refused by the organization. If unsure, please consult the GNSK organization in advance.

We will do our best to provide sufficient power outlets and lighting at the campsite, but please note that these may be limited. We recommend bringing a flashlight and an extra power bank for added comfort.

The Radboud Centrum will be accessible at night, and the campsite will have security present 24/7.

Camping Rules

These rules are in place to ensure a pleasant and safe weekend for everyone. The organization and security staff reserve the right to remove anyone who does not comply with these regulations. You must follow the instructions of security staff, the organization, and volunteers at all times.

1. The general terms and conditions of GNSK 2025 apply to the campsite.
2. Visitors are only allowed on the campsite upon showing their accreditation in the GNSK 2025 App after registering at the registration desk in the Radboud Sports Centre.
3. Camp only in the designated areas.



4. Your tent must be appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents may be refused.
5. Caravans, campers, and folding trailers are not allowed.
6. Passenger vehicles are not allowed on the campsite. These can be parked for a fee around the campus.
7. The campsite opens on Friday at 4:00 PM. Tents must be removed by Sunday, June 22, no later than 6:00 PM.
8. Arrival at the campsite is possible until Saturday, June 21, at 8:00 PM. Upon first arrival, report to a volunteer who will assign your camping spot.
9. A certified emergency responder (BHV'er) will be present from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM in the tent next to the campsite.
10. Security and/or volunteers will monitor the campsite throughout the weekend. In case of emergencies, contact them or the central information desk at the Radboud Sports Centre.
11. Leaving personal items is at your own risk. The organization is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.
12. Sufficient toilet facilities are available next to the campsite. Keep them clean and tidy for the next user.
13. Power supply at the campsite is limited.
14. Open flames, including BBQs and gas cylinders, are prohibited. Cooking is not allowed due to fire safety.
15. Waste must be disposed of in the designated bins.
16. Respect the sleep of others. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Sound systems are not allowed during this time.
17. Pets are not allowed on the campsite.
18. Commercial activity, advertising, or distributing publications near the entrances or on the campsite is only allowed with prior written permission from the organization.
19. You may bring and consume your own food and drinks on the campsite, but all waste must be cleaned up.
20. Alcohol consumption is allowed, but only in cans or plastic containers.
21. Strong alcoholic beverages and any form of drugs are strictly prohibited.





22. Glass is not allowed on the campsite for safety reasons. Bags will be checked upon entry.

23. Smoking is only allowed in the designated areas next to the campsite, not on the campsite itself.

24. Upon departure on Sunday, security or volunteers may check your camping spot. You may be asked to clean up any remaining waste.

Wedstrijdreglement Basketbal

GNSK 2025

Teamsamenstelling en speelgerechtigdheid

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (OSSO)/stad kunnen maximaal twee heren en damesteams ingeschreven worden. Een team bestaat uit minimaal 5 en maximaal 12 spelers.

Het eerste ingeschreven team per OSSO/stad heeft altijd recht om mee te doen. Afhankelijk van het aantal ingeschreven teams wordt besloten of het tweede team mee kan doen. Mochten er te veel tweede teams zijn voor de overgebleven plekken, gaat deelname op basis van volgorde van inschrijving.

2. De ingeschreven deelnemers van een OSSO/stad mogen uitsluitend bestaan uit studenten die voldoen aan de voorwaarden als gesteld in hoofdstuk 1 van het evenementenreglement van SSN. Bij overtreding van deze regel verliest het team alle wedstrijden. Als er een ongerechtigde deelnemer meedoet aan het GNSK, wordt er een boete van €200,- in rekening gebracht bij de OSSO/vertegenwoordigende organisatie in de stad voor welke die deelnemer uitkomt.

3. De teamopgave dient voor aanvang van iedere wedstrijd doorgegeven te worden aan de basketbalcommissie. Mocht een OSSO/stad twee deelnemende teams sturen, kunnen er in overleg met de basketbalcommissie spelers in het andere team meespelen (bij blessure, ziekte of andere goede reden). Mocht dit zonder overleg gebeuren, dan geldt artikel 2.

4. De winnaar van het basketbaltoernooi van het GNSK 2025 kwalificeert zich voor de European Universities Championships (EUC) in 2026.

Wedstrijdbepalingen

5. De voorrondes bestaan uit poules. De poule-indeling geschiedt op basis van loting, waarbij teams geplaatst worden volgens de Uitvoeringsregeling Plaatsing GNSK 2025 en indien mogelijk teams van eenzelfde OSSO/stad worden verdeeld over verschillende poules. De basketbal commissie beslist voor de loting hoeveel teams per poule zich kwalificeren voor het finaleschema dat door middel van een knock-outsysteem wordt gespeeld.



6. Bij een gewonnen wedstrijd krijgt een team 2 punten, bij een gelijkspel 1. De eindstand van de poule wordt bepaald op basis van het aantal punten dat een team behaald heeft. Bij een gelijke stand in een poulefase beslist achtereenvolgens het onderlinge resultaat en het puntensaldo. Als er nog geen beslissing is bereikt, nemen per team vijf verschillende spelers ieder één vrije worp. Indien nodig nemen hierna beide teams om beurten een vrije worp totdat er een beslissing is gevallen.

7. De duur van een wedstrijd is bepaald op 25 minuten doorlopende speeltijd zonder wissel van speelhelte en zonder pauze, waarbij de laatste 3 minuten zuivere speeltijd is. De finale bestaat uit twee maal 15 minuten zuivere speeltijd, waarbij er een rust is tussen de helte van 5 minuten en een wissel van speelhelte.

8. Per wedstrijd is 1 keer een time-out toegestaan per team van maximaal 1 minuut, waarbij de speeltijd gewoon doorloopt. Valt deze time-out in de zuivere speeltijd (tijdens de laatste drie minuten van een wedstrijd of tijdens de gehele finale), dan stopt de tijd wel.

9. De spelers mogen onbeperkt gewisseld worden, maar alleen tijdens een dood spelmoment (na fluitsignaal scheidsrechter).

10. In een poulefase is gelijkspel mogelijk. Eindigt in het verdere toernooi een wedstrijd gelijk, dan zal er met 5 minuten zuivere speeltijd verlengd worden. Indien er dan nog geen winnaar is, nemen per team vijf verschillende spelers ieder één vrije worp. Indien nodig nemen hierna beide teams om beurten een vrije worp totdat er een beslissing is gevallen.

11. De teams dienen op het in het wedstrijdschema aangegeven tijdstip aanwezig en speelklaar te zijn. Indien het team niet aanwezig is op het opgegeven tijdstip, dan verliest het team de wedstrijd. De uitslag is dan 20-0 in het voordeel van het aanwezige team.

12. Het streven is om voor iedere wedstrijd NBB-scheidsrechters te regelen. Mocht dit niet lukken dan dienen niet-spelende teams, volgens het wedstrijdschema, spelers aan te dragen om scheidsrechter te zijn bij andere wedstrijden. Zij dienen op het aangegeven tijdstip aanwezig en klaar te zijn.

13. De teams dienen shirts met nummers te dragen. Zo nodig dient de ploeg die als tweede op het wedstrijdschema wordt genoemd voor reserveshirts te zorgen.



14. Er wordt gespeeld met officieel goedgekeurde wedstrijdballen. De wedstrijdballen worden verstrekt door de basketbalcommissie. De oefenballen dienen zelf meegenomen te worden.

15. Een speler met vier persoonlijke fouten wordt voor de verdere duur van de wedstrijd uitgesloten.

16. Bij twee technische fouten of één onsportieve fout wordt de speler voor de verdere duur van de wedstrijd uitgesloten.

17. Bij een diskwalificerende fout wordt de speler voor de verdere duur van het toernooi uitgesloten.

18. De teamfoutenregel geldt tot aan de finale vanaf de achtste fout die wordt gemaakt door één team. Vanaf de achtste teamfout, wordt iedere verdedigende fout bestraft met één punt en balbezit voor het aanvallende team.

19. In de finale geldt de teamfoutenregel vanaf de vijfde fout per helft (15 minuten). Vanaf de vijfde ploegfout, wordt iedere fout bestraft met twee vrije worpen.

20. In de finale worden persoonlijke fouten bestraft volgens [FIBA-reglement](#). Een speler met vier persoonlijke fouten wordt voor de verdere duur van de wedstrijd uitgesloten.

21. Tijdens het spel worden fouten niet bestraft met vrije worpen, maar op de volgende manier:

- Fout tegen een niet-schietende speler: balbezit;
- Fout tegen een schietende speler die niet scoort: 1 punt en balbezit;
- Fout tegen een schietende speler die scoort: score + 1 punt bonus;
- Technische fout: 1 punt en balbezit;
- Onsportieve en diskwalificerende fouten (laten we zorgen dat het nooit zover komt): 2 punten en balbezit.

22. Protesten worden niet geaccepteerd voor zover deze scheidsrechterlijke beslissingen betreffen.

Slotbepalingen

23. Spelers dienen gepaste schoenen te dragen.

24. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor ongevallen of schade aan derden vóór, tijdens of na de wedstrijd. Deelname geschiedt op



25. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor diefstal vóór, tijdens of na de competitie.

26. Voor zover in bovenstaande punten geen uitzondering wordt gemaakt, zijn de [reglementen van FIBA](#) van kracht.

27. In alle gevallen behoudt de basketbalcommissie zich het recht voor om een bindende beslissing te nemen

Regulations Basketball

GNSK 2025

Team composition and eligibility

1. A maximum of two men's and women's teams can be registered per Umbrella Student Sports Organisation (OSSO)/city. A team consists of a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 12 players. The first registered team per OSSO/city is always entitled to participate. Depending on the number of registered teams, it will be decided whether the second team can participate. If there are too many second teams for the remaining places, participation will be based on the order of registration.

2. The registered participants of an OSSO/city may only consist of students who meet the conditions as stated in chapter 1 of the SSN event regulations. In the event of violation of this rule, the team will lose all matches. If an ineligible participant participates in the GNSK, a fine of €200 will be charged to the OSSO/representative organisation in the city for which that participant plays.

3. The team registration must be submitted to the basketball committee before the start of each match. Should an OSSO/city send two participating teams, players in the other team may play in consultation with the basketball committee (in case of injury, illness or other good reason). Should this happen without consultation, article 2.

4. The winner of the GNSK basketball tournament 2025 qualifies for the European Universities Championships (EUC) in 2026.

Match provisions

5. The preliminary rounds consist of groups. The group division is based on a draw, whereby teams are placed according to the Implementation Regulation Placement GNSK 2025 and, if possible, teams from the same OSSO/city are divided into different groups. The basketball committee decides before the draw how many teams per group qualify for the final schedule that is played by means of a knock-out system.



6. For a won match, a team receives 2 points, for a draw 1. The final position of the group is determined on the basis of the number of points that a team has achieved. In the event of a tie in a group phase, the mutual result and the point difference decide successively. If no decision has been reached yet, five different players per team each take one free throw. If necessary, both teams then take a free throw in turn until a decision has been made.

7. The duration of a match is set at 25 minutes of continuous playing time without a change of ends and without a break, with the last 3 minutes being pure playing time. The final consists of two halves of 15 minutes pure playing time, with a break of 5 minutes between the halves and a change of ends.

8. One time-out per team is allowed per match, with a maximum of 1 minute, during which playing time continues. If this time-out falls within pure playing time (during the last three minutes of a match or ten minutes of a match), the time-out is not allowed.

9. Players may be substituted an unlimited number of times, but only during a dead ball moment (after the referee's whistle).

10. A draw is possible in a group stage. If a match ends in a draw in the rest of the tournament, there will be 5 minutes of pure playing time extended. If there is still no winner, five different players per team will each take one free throw. If necessary, both teams will then take a free throw in turn until a decision has been made.

11. The teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the match schedule. If the team is not present at the specified time, it will lose the match. The score will then be 20-0 in favour of the team present.

12. The aim is to arrange NBB referees for every match. If this is not possible, non-playing teams must, according to the match schedule, nominate players to be referees for other matches. They must be present and ready at the specified time.

13. The teams must wear shirts with numbers. If necessary, the team listed second on the schedule must provide spare shirts.

14. Officially approved match balls will be used. The match balls will be provided by the basketball committee. You must bring your own practice balls.

15. A player with four personal fouls is excluded from the remainder of the game.

16. With two technical fouls or one unsportsmanlike foul, the player is excluded from the remainder of the game.



17. With a disqualifying foul, the player is excluded from the remainder of the tournament.

18. The team foul rule applies until the final from the eighth foul committed by one team. From the eighth team foul, each defensive foul is penalized with one point and possession of the ball for the attacking team.

19. In the final, the team foul rule applies from the fifth foul per half (15 minutes). From the fifth team foul, each foul is penalized with two free throws.

20. In the final, personal fouls are penalized according to FIBA rules. A player with four personal fouls is excluded from the remainder of the game.

21. During the game, fouls are not penalized with free throws, but in the following way:

- Foul against a non-shooting player: possession of the ball;
- Foul against a shooting player who does not score: 1 point and possession of the ball;
- Foul against a shooting player who scores: score + 1 bonus point;
- Technical foul: 1 point and possession of the ball;
- Unsportsmanlike and disqualifying fouls (let's make sure it never comes to that): 2 points and possession of the ball.

22. Protests will not be accepted as far as they concern refereeing decisions.

Closing Provisions

23. Players must wear appropriate footwear.

24. The organization is not responsible for accidents or damage to third parties before, during or after the game. Participation is at your own risk.

25. The organization is not responsible for theft before, during or after the competition.

26. Unless an exception is made in the above points, the [reglementen van FIBA](#) apply.

27. In all cases, the basketball committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
