Competition venue

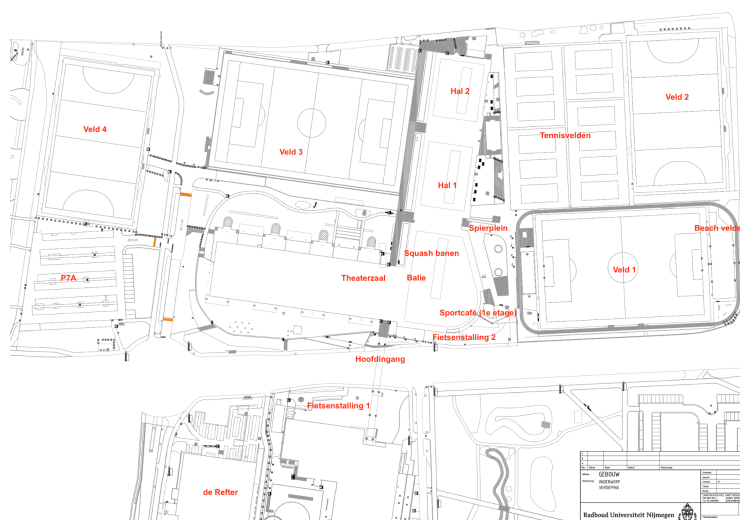

Before participating in any matches at the competition venue, registration is required at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum (see below for more information).

Registration GNSK 2024

Signing up and registration for the GNSK 2025 must be done before participating in the sports tournament. This can be done on Friday in sporthal IC and on Saturday at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum. The address is: **Heyendaalseweg 141, 6525 AJ Nijmegen.**

You can sign up the following times:

- Saturday 21 June: 8u tot 13u

You must be able to provide the following documents before applying:

- Valid certificate of registration from the educational institution, or certificate of graduation (*Only required for participants, not for team officials*)
- Valid accreditation card on the GNSK 2025 app (*see below GNSK 2025 app*)
- Valid passport, ID card or driving license

After this is done, participants and team officials can go to the competition venue with a valid accreditation.

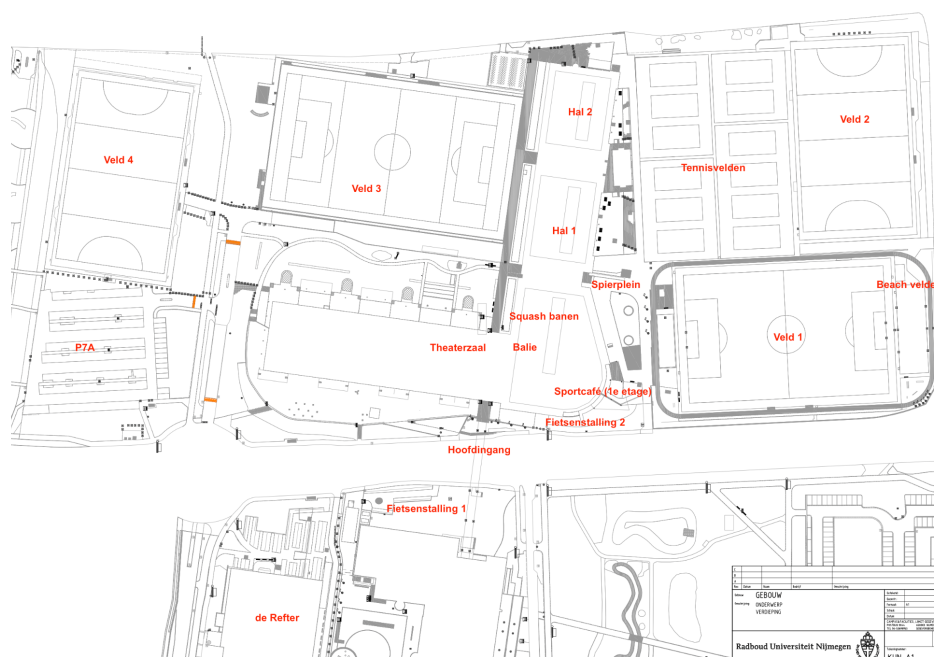
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Map Radboud Sportcentrum



GNSK 2025 app

Once again this year there is the GNSK app containing all the information about the GNSK, such as first aid, party and competition programmes. Importantly, the app is used for accreditation during the GNSK and every participant and team official must download this app. In the following steps, you can download the app and request your personal accreditation:

Step 1: Download the GNSK app for Android or Apple

Step 2: Open the GNSK app and click on three bars in the top left corner.

Step 3: Click on 'accreditation'

Step 4: Enter your phone number

Step 5: Enter the verification code you receive in a sms

Catering

Breakfast

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with breakfast. The breakfast buffet is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Breakfast is served from 6:30 to 9:00 AM. Specific time slots will be announced later.



The breakfast includes:

- Bread: Whole wheat bread / White bread
- Toppings: Cheese / Chicken breast / Strawberry jam / Chocolate sprinkles / Boiled egg
- Other: Mini donut / Hangop (strained yogurt) / Muesli / Fruit
- Drinks: Coffee / Tea / Orange juice

Lunch

During the weekend, participants and team officials are responsible for arranging their own lunch. Various food stalls will be available at the Radboud Sports Centre, and you can also visit *The Yard*, the sports café located inside the centre.

Dinner

Dinner on Friday and Saturday is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with dinner. Dinner is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Dinner is served from 5:00 to 8:00 PM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

Meals are served vegetarian by default. Please indicate any dietary requirements when registering.

- Friday dinner: Pasta Bolognese with Italian salad and ciabatta
- Saturday dinner: Rice with chicken curry and cucumber salad

Campsite

Accommodation is provided at the Radboud Sportcentrum in the sports halls and at a campsite located at Sportpark D'Almarasweg.

Sleeping facilities are only available to those who indicated this during their registration for GNSK 2025. Participants will either sleep in the indoor sports halls or camp on a grass field using their own tents.

Those staying in the sports halls must bring their own sleeping gear (including mat or air mattress, blanket, and pillow).





Those camping outdoors must bring their own tents and full sleeping equipment. It's important to bring a tent appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents for too few people may be refused by the organization. If unsure, please consult the GNSK organization in advance.

We will do our best to provide sufficient power outlets and lighting at the campsite, but please note that these may be limited. We recommend bringing a flashlight and an extra power bank for added comfort.

The Radboud Centrum will be accessible at night, and the campsite will have security present 24/7.

Camping Rules

These rules are in place to ensure a pleasant and safe weekend for everyone. The organization and security staff reserve the right to remove anyone who does not comply with these regulations. You must follow the instructions of security staff, the organization, and volunteers at all times.

1. The general terms and conditions of GNSK 2025 apply to the campsite.
2. Visitors are only allowed on the campsite upon showing their accreditation in the GNSK 2025 App after registering at the registration desk in the Radboud Sports Centre.
3. Camp only in the designated areas.
4. Your tent must be appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents may be refused.
5. Caravans, campers, and folding trailers are not allowed.
6. Passenger vehicles are not allowed on the campsite. These can be parked for a fee around the campus.
7. The campsite opens on Friday at 4:00 PM. Tents must be removed by Sunday, June 22, no later than 6:00 PM.
8. Arrival at the campsite is possible until Saturday, June 21, at 8:00 PM. Upon first arrival, report to a volunteer who will assign your camping spot.
9. A certified emergency responder (BHV'er) will be present from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM in the tent next to the campsite.
10. Security and/or volunteers will monitor the campsite throughout the weekend. In case of emergencies, contact them or the central information



desk at the Radboud Sports Centre.

11. Leaving personal items is at your own risk. The organization is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.

12. Sufficient toilet facilities are available next to the campsite. Keep them clean and tidy for the next user.

13. Power supply at the campsite is limited.

14. Open flames, including BBQs and gas cylinders, are prohibited. Cooking is not allowed due to fire safety.

15. Waste must be disposed of in the designated bins.

16. Respect the sleep of others. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Sound systems are not allowed during this time.

17. Pets are not allowed on the campsite.

18. Commercial activity, advertising, or distributing publications near the entrances or on the campsite is only allowed with prior written permission from the organization.

19. You may bring and consume your own food and drinks on the campsite, but all waste must be cleaned up.

20. Alcohol consumption is allowed, but only in cans or plastic containers.

21. Strong alcoholic beverages and any form of drugs are strictly prohibited.

22. Glass is not allowed on the campsite for safety reasons. Bags will be checked upon entry.

23. Smoking is only allowed in the designated areas next to the campsite, not on the campsite itself.

24. Upon departure on Sunday, security or volunteers may check your camping spot. You may be asked to clean up any remaining waste.

To officially kick off the GNSK together, a welcome speech and group warm-up will be organized on Friday at 7:00 PM on Field 1 of the Radboud Sports Centre.

Wedstrijdreglementen (NL en ENG)

Wedstrijdreglement Schaken

GNSK 2025

Speelgerechtigdheid

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (hierna: OSSO)/stad kunnen meerdere individuen worden ingeschreven. Afhankelijk van het aantal ingeschreven individuen wordt besloten of de andere individuen mee kunnen doen. Mochten er te veel individuen zijn voor de overgebleven plekken, gaat deelname op basis van volgorde van inschrijving.
2. De ingeschreven deelnemers van een OSSO/stad mogen uitsluitend bestaan uit studenten die voldoen aan de voorwaarden als gesteld in hoofdstuk 1 van het evenementenreglement van SSN. Bij overtreding van deze regel worden alle resultaten van deze deelnemer geschrapt. Als er een ongerechtigde deelnemer meedoet aan het GNSK, wordt er een boete van €200,- in rekening gebracht bij de OSSO/vertegenwoordigende organisatie in de stad voor welke die deelnemer uitkomt.
3. GNSK Ticket verschaft zowel toegang tot het Blitz toernooi als het Rapidtoernooi. Spelers kunnen ervoor kiezen om slechts één van de twee toernooien mee te doen.
4. Deelnemers moeten zich vooraf inschrijven via GNSK of ter plaatse inschrijven voor aanvang van de eerste ronde, deelnemers dienen dan wel al via GNSK geregistreerd te zijn voor andere evenementen indien plaatsen beschikbaar zijn.

Wedstrijdbepalingen

5. Algemene Informatie

5.1. Het toernooi wordt gespeeld volgens de regels van FIDE.

5.1.1. Met uitzondering van regel 5.1: loslaten van een stuk geldt als een definitieve zet, tenzij een ongeldige zet is gedaan.

5.2. Het rapidtoernooi wordt gehouden op 21 en 22 juni in Nijmegen op een door GNSK aangewezen locatie.



5.3. Het blitztoernooi wordt gehouden op 20 juni in Nijmegen op een door GNSK aangewezen locatie.

5.4. Het sportprogramma wordt bekendgemaakt op de officiële toernooi website van GNSK en is leidend voor beide toernooien.

5.5. De deelnemers van het GNSK Rapid Schaken strijden om de titel van beste studenten schaakstad. Deelnemers kunnen gepaard worden tegen vertegenwoordigers van dezelfde stad.

6. Speelsysteem

6.1. Het blitztoernooi wordt gespeeld volgens het Zwitsers systeem met 11 ronden.

6.2. Het rapidtoernooi wordt gespeeld volgens het Zwitsers systeem met 9 Rondes: 6 op zaterdag en 3 op zondag.

7. Speeltempo

7.1. Het speeltempo tijdens het rapidtoernooi bedraagt 15 minuten met een bonus van 10 seconden per zet per speler.

7.2. Het speeltempo tijdens het blitztoernooi bedraagt 3 minuten met een bonus van 2 seconden per zet per speler.

8. Wedstrijdvoorschriften

8.1. Zodra een speler een stuk heeft losgelaten is de zet onherroepelijk tenzij een ongeldige zet is gedaan (bijv. schaak in stand laten).

8.2. Een remise mag alleen worden aangeboden nadat een speler een zet heeft gedaan. De tegenstander kan de remise vervolgens accepteren of weigeren en doorspelen.

8.3. Het gebruik van elektronische apparaten tijdens een partij is strikt verboden. Overtreding kan leiden tot onmiddellijke diskwalificatie.

8.3.1. Bij afgaan van een mobiel apparaat zal eerst een waarschuwing worden gegeven; bij herhaling leidt het tot verlies van partij of eventueel diskwalificatie te bepalen door de arbiter.

9. Arbitrage en Geschillen

9.1. De arbiter is verantwoordelijk voor het toezicht op de naleving van de regels.



9.2. Bij geschillen of onduidelijkheden is de beslissing van de arbiter bindend en hiertegen kan geen beroep worden aangetekend.

9.3. Spelers kunnen een arbiter inschakelen door hun klok stil te zetten en de arbiter te roepen. Het misbruiken van deze procedure kan bestraft worden.

10. Strafmaatregelen

10.1. Ongepast gedrag, het niet respecteren van de tegenstander of de wedstrijdleiding kan leiden tot waarschuwingen, tijdstraffen, of uitsluiting van het toernooi.

10.2. De verzuimtijd bedraagt 5 min van het vastgestelde tijdstip.

10.3. Spelers die zich zonder geldige reden terugtrekken uit het toernooi, kunnen uitgesloten worden van toekomstige toernooien.

11. Prijzen

11.1. Er zijn prijzen voor de hoogste eindposities van beide toernooien. De prijzen worden nader bekendgemaakt door het GNSK.

11.2. De podiumplaatsen worden berekend door de gemiddelde score van de drie spelers die het beste presteren namens hun studentenstad. Indien er minder dan drie deelnemers van één studentenstad komen, geldt nog steeds het gemiddelde, berekend door het aantal behaalde punten gedeeld door het aantal deelnemers.

11.3. Indien twee steden gelijk staan na alle rondes, worden de best presterende spelers van beide delegaties geselecteerd voor een armageddon.

11.3.1. Gelijke stand tussen twee delegaties:

11.3.1.1. Bij een gelijk aantal punten tussen twee spelers voor een podiumplaats, wordt er een beslissende armageddon gespeeld met een speeltempo waar de spelers mogen bieden om zwarte stukken te gebruiken. De maximale tijd is 10 minuten zonder bonus tijd. Wit heeft dus 10 minuten, en zwart heeft het laagste bod. Zwart wint een armageddon bij een remise. De winnaar van deze partij wint de betreffende podiumplaats.

11.3.2. Gelijke stand tussen meer dan twee delegaties:



11.3.2.1. Als er meer dan twee delegaties zijn met een gelijk aantal punten voor een podiumplaats, worden de volgende criteria in volgorde toegepast om twee spelers te selecteren voor de armageddon.

11.3.2.1.1. Buchholz: Het totaal aantal punten behaald door de tegenstanders van de betreffende spelers.

11.3.2.1.2. Sonneborn-Berger: De som van de scores van de verslagen tegenstanders gewogen naar het resultaat tegen hen.

11.3.2.1.3. In geval er geen tweetal kan worden geselecteerd zal het lot bepalen.

11.4. Voor andere plaatsen anders dan de podiumplaatsen wordt de eindstand bepaald aan de hand van de standaard tiebreak criteria (Buchholz en Sonneborn-Berger).

Slotbepalingen

12. In alle gevallen waarin dit reglement niet voorziet, beslist de toernooileiding in samenspraak met de arbiter.

13. Door deelname aan het toernooi verklaart iedere speler zich akkoord met dit reglement.

Regulations Chess

GNSK 2025

Eligibility

1. Several individuals can be registered per Overarching Student Sports Organisation (hereinafter: OSSO)/city. Depending on the number of individuals registered, it will be decided whether the other individuals can participate. Should there be too many individuals for the remaining spots, participation will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

2. The registered participants of an OSSO/city may only consist of students who meet the conditions set out in Chapter 1 of SSN's event regulations. If this rule is violated, all results of this participant will be deleted. If an unauthorised participant competes in the GNSK, a fine of €200 will be charged to the OSSO/representing organisation in the city for which that participant competes.





3. The GNSK Ticket grants access to both the Blitz and the Rapid tournaments. Players may choose to participate in only one of the two tournaments.

4. Participants must register in advance via GNSK or on-site before the start of the first round. However, participants must already be registered with GNSK for other events if spots are available.

Match provisions

5. General Information

5.1. The tournament will be played according to FIDE rules.

5.2. With exception to Rule 5.1: Releasing a piece constitutes a definitive move unless an illegal move has been made.

5.3. The rapid tournament will take place on June 21 and 22 in Nijmegen at a location determined by GNSK.

5.4. The blitz tournament will be held on June 20 in Nijmegen at a location determined by GNSK.

5.5. The sports program will be announced on the official GNSK tournament website and is binding for both tournaments.

6. Tournament System

6.1. The blitz tournament will be played according to the Swiss system with 11 rounds.

6.2. The rapid tournament will be played according to the Swiss system with 9 rounds: 6 on Saturday and 3 on Sunday.

7. Time Control

7.1. The time control during the rapid tournament is 15 minutes with a 10-second increment per move per player.

7.2. The time control during the blitz tournament is 3 minutes with a 2-second increment per move per player.

8. Match Regulations

8.1. Once a player has released a piece, the move is irrevocable unless an illegal move has been made (e.g., leaving a king in check).



8.2. A draw may only be offered after a player has made a move. The opponent may then accept the draw or decline and continue playing.

8.3. The use of electronic devices during a game is strictly prohibited. Violation may lead to immediate disqualification.

8.3.1. If a mobile device rings, a warning will first be given; repeated violations may result in the loss of the game or disqualification, as determined by the arbiter.

9. Arbitration and Disputes

9.1. The arbiter is responsible for ensuring compliance with the rules.

9.2. In case of disputes or ambiguities, the arbiter's decision is final and cannot be appealed.

9.3. Players may call an arbiter by stopping their clock and summoning the arbiter. Abuse of this procedure may result in penalties.

10. Sanctions

10.1. Inappropriate behavior, disrespecting opponents or officials may result in warnings, time penalties, or exclusion from the tournament.

10.2. The default time is 5 minutes from the scheduled start time.

10.3. Players who withdraw from the tournament without valid reason may be barred from future tournaments.

11. Prizes

11.1. Prizes will be awarded for the top positions in both tournaments. Prizes will be announced at a later date.

11.2. In the event of a tie for the podium places (1st, 2nd, and 3rd places), the following procedure will be applied:

11.2.1. – Tie between Two Players:

11.2.1.1. If two players have the same points for a podium place, a decisive armageddon match will be played with a time control where players may bid for the black pieces. The maximum time is 10 minutes with no increment. White has 10 minutes, and black has the lowest bid. Black wins the armageddon in the case of a draw. The winner of this game takes the respective podium position.





11.2.2. - Tie between More than Two Players:

11.2.2.1. If more than two players have the same points for a podium place, the following criteria will be applied in order to select two players for the armageddon:

11.2.2.1.1. - Buchholz: The total number of points scored by the player's opponents.

11.2.2.1.2. - Sonneborn-Berger: The sum of the scores of the defeated opponents, weighted by the result against them.

11.2.2.1.3. - If a pair cannot be selected, a random draw will determine the participants.

11.3. For places other than the podium, the final standings will be determined by the standard tiebreak criteria (Buchholz and Sonneborn-Berger).

Closing Provisions

12. In all cases not covered by these regulations, the tournament committee will decide in consultation with the arbiter.

13. By participating in the tournament, each player agrees to these regulations.
