Timetable

On Friday, June 20th, the first teams scheduled to play will gather at 17:30, with matches starting at 18:00. Group stage matches will be played during this time. Play will continue until 23:00.

On Saturday, June 21st, matches will be played from 09:00 to 18:00, divided into two sessions: 09:00–13:00 and 14:00–18:00. After 18:00, a social program organized by the GNSK committee will take place.

On Sunday, June 22nd, matches will be played from 09:00 to 16:00. At 09:00, the men's semifinals will begin. At 10:30, the final group stage matches for the women's teams will be played. At 14:00, the men's final and the consolation match will take place. Afterwards, the award ceremony will be held at 18:00 at the Radboud Sports Centre.





If the situation arises that one or more matches run overtime, play may continue and the schedule will be adjusted. In this, the N.S.L.T.C. Slow committee will make the final decision.

Match schedules

The match schedules can be found in the GNSK 2025 app under the "Match Schedules" section. Instructions and explanations about the app can be found below.

The group stage of the men's team tournament will be played in 3 groups of 3 teams each. This will be followed by semifinals and finals. The group stage of the women's team tournament will consist of 2 groups of 4 teams each.

Tennis related issues

It is important to read through the regulations (*see at the very end of this playbook*) for all participants and team officials.

The matches will be played on artificial grass courts at the Radboud Sports Centre. The balls used will be Wilson Roland Garros All Court.

Competition venue

Tennis is played on Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the Radboud Sportcentrum on the tennis courts. The address is: **Heyendaalseweg 141, 6525 AJ Nijmegen**

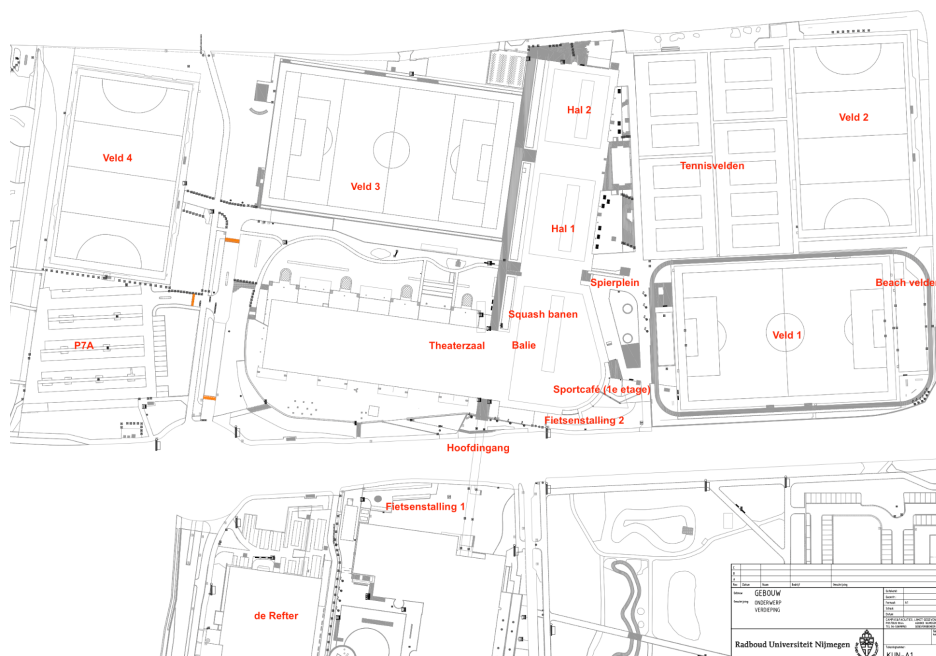
Public Transport: From Nijmegen train station, take bus lines 10, 14, or 15 to the *Erasmusgebouw* bus stop.

Car: GNSK participants can use parking areas P7A and P13 of Radboud University free of charge.

Before participating in any matches at the competition venue, registration is required at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum (see below for more information).

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday there will be played on 12 tennis courts.

Registration GNSK 2024

Signing up and registration for the GNSK 2025 must be done before participating in the sports tournament. This can be done on Friday in hall 1C and on Saturday at the registration desk in the Radboud Sportcentrum. The address is: **Heyendaalseweg 141, 6525 AJ Nijmegen**. You can sign up the following times:

- Friday 20 June: 16.00 till 20.00
- Saturday 21 June: 8.00 till 13.00

You must be able to provide the following documents before applying:

- Valid certificate of registration from the educational institution, or certificate of graduation (*Only required for participants, not for team officials*)
- Valid accreditation card on the GNSK 2025 app (see below GNSK 2025 app)



- Valid passport, ID card or driving license

After this is done, participants and team officials can go to the competition venue with a valid accreditation.

Transport to Radboud Sportcentrum

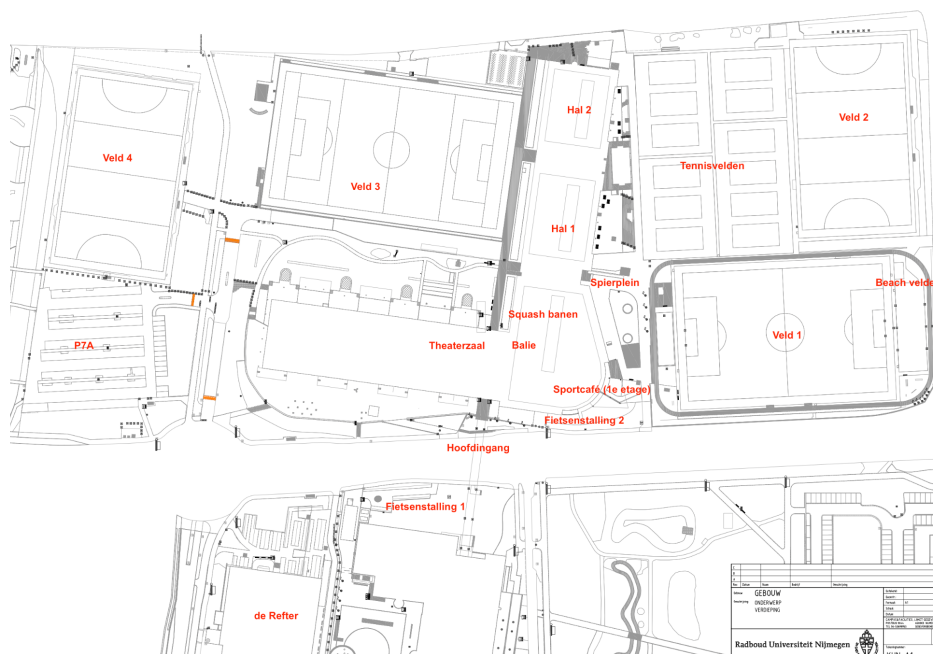

GNSK 2025 app

Once again this year there is the GNSK app containing all the information about the GNSK, such as first aid, party and competition programmes. Importantly, the app is used for accreditation during the GNSK and every



participant and team official must download this app. In the following steps, you can download the app and request your personal accreditation:

Catering

Breakfast

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with breakfast. The breakfast buffet is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Breakfast is served from 6:30 to 9:00 AM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

The breakfast includes:

- Bread: Whole wheat bread / White bread
- Toppings: Cheese / Chicken breast / Strawberry jam / Chocolate sprinkles / Boiled egg
- Other: Mini donut / Hangop (strained yogurt) / Muesli / Fruit
- Drinks: Coffee / Tea / Orange juice

Lunch

During the weekend, participants and team officials are responsible for arranging their own lunch. Various food stalls will be available at the Radboud Sports Centre, and you can also visit *The Yard*, the sports café located inside the centre.

Dinner

Dinner on Friday and Saturday is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with dinner. Dinner is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.





Dinner is served from 5:00 to 8:00 PM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

Meals are served vegetarian by default. Please indicate any dietary requirements when registering.

- Friday dinner: Pasta Bolognese with Italian salad and ciabatta
- Saturday dinner: Rice with chicken curry and cucumber salad

Campsite

Accommodation is provided at the Radboud Sportcentrum in the sports halls and at a campsite located at Sportpark D'Almarasweg.

Sleeping facilities are only available to those who indicated this during their registration for GNSK 2025. Participants will either sleep in the indoor sports halls or camp on a grass field using their own tents.

Those staying in the sports halls must bring their own sleeping gear (including mat or air mattress, blanket, and pillow).

Those camping outdoors must bring their own tents and full sleeping equipment. It's important to bring a tent appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents for too few people may be refused by the organization. If unsure, please consult the GNSK organization in advance.

We will do our best to provide sufficient power outlets and lighting at the campsite, but please note that these may be limited. We recommend bringing a flashlight and an extra power bank for added comfort.

The Radboud Centrum will be accessible at night, and the campsite will have security present 24/7.

Camping Rules

These rules are in place to ensure a pleasant and safe weekend for everyone. The organization and security staff reserve the right to remove anyone who does not comply with these regulations. You must follow the instructions of security staff, the organization, and volunteers at all times.

1. The general terms and conditions of GNSK 2025 apply to the campsite.



2. Visitors are only allowed on the campsite upon showing their accreditation in the GNSK 2025 App after registering at the registration desk in the Radboud Sports Centre.
3. Camp only in the designated areas.
4. Your tent must be appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents may be refused.
5. Caravans, campers, and folding trailers are not allowed.
6. Passenger vehicles are not allowed on the campsite. These can be parked for a fee around the campus.
7. The campsite opens on Friday at 4:00 PM. Tents must be removed by Sunday, June 22, no later than 6:00 PM.
8. Arrival at the campsite is possible until Saturday, June 21, at 8:00 PM. Upon first arrival, report to a volunteer who will assign your camping spot.
9. A certified emergency responder (BHV'er) will be present from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM in the tent next to the campsite.
10. Security and/or volunteers will monitor the campsite throughout the weekend. In case of emergencies, contact them or the central information desk at the Radboud Sports Centre.
11. Leaving personal items is at your own risk. The organization is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.
12. Sufficient toilet facilities are available next to the campsite. Keep them clean and tidy for the next user.
13. Power supply at the campsite is limited.
14. Open flames, including BBQs and gas cylinders, are prohibited. Cooking is not allowed due to fire safety.
15. Waste must be disposed of in the designated bins.
16. Respect the sleep of others. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Sound systems are not allowed during this time.
17. Pets are not allowed on the campsite.
18. Commercial activity, advertising, or distributing publications near the entrances or on the campsite is only allowed with prior written permission from the organization.
19. You may bring and consume your own food and drinks on the campsite, but all waste must be cleaned up.



- 20. Alcohol consumption is allowed, but only in cans or plastic containers.
- 21. Strong alcoholic beverages and any form of drugs are strictly prohibited.
- 22. Glass is not allowed on the campsite for safety reasons. Bags will be checked upon entry.
- 23. Smoking is only allowed in the designated areas next to the campsite, not on the campsite itself.
- 24. Upon departure on Sunday, security or volunteers may check your camping spot. You may be asked to clean up any remaining waste.

To officially kick off the GNSK together, a welcome speech and group warm-up will be organized on Friday at 7:00 PM on Field 1 of the Radboud Sports Centre.

Wedstrijdreglement Tennis

GNSK 2025

Teamsamenstelling en speelgerechtigdheid

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (hierna: OSSO)/stad kunnen maximaal twee heren- en twee damesteams ingeschreven worden. Een team bestaat uit minimaal 2 en maximaal 4 spelers. Het eerste ingeschreven team per OSSO/stad heeft altijd recht om mee te doen. Afhankelijk van het aantal ingeschreven teams wordt besloten of het tweede team mee kan doen. Mochten er te veel tweede teams zijn voor de overgebleven plekken, gaat deelname op basis van volgorde van inschrijving.
2. De ingeschreven deelnemers van een OSSO/stad mogen uitsluitend bestaan uit studenten die voldoen aan de voorwaarden als gesteld in hoofdstuk 1 van het evenementenreglement van SSN. Bij overtreding van deze regel verliest het team alle wedstrijden. Als er een ongerechtigde deelnemer meedoet aan het GNSK, wordt er een boete van €200,- in rekening gebracht bij de OSSO/vertegenwoordigende organisatie in de stad voor welke die deelnemer uitkomt.
3. Bij inschrijving dient de officiële persoonlijke ranking of speelsterkte volgens de KNLTB (indien beschikbaar) aangegeven te worden (met speelsterkte wordt het niveau van een speler aangegeven waarbij 1 het hoogste is en 9 het laagste).
4. De teamopstelling dient 15 minuten voor aanvang van iedere teamwedstrijd doorgegeven te worden aan de tenniscommissie. Mocht een OSSO/stad twee deelnemende teams sturen, dan mogen er geen spelers gewisseld worden of bij het andere team meespelen. Mocht dit wel gebeuren, dan geldt artikel 2.
5. De winnaar van het tennistoernooi van het GNSK 2025 kwalificeert zich voor de European Universities Championships (EUC) in 2026.

Wedstrijdbepalingen

6. De voorrondes bestaan uit poules. De poule-indeling geschiedt op basis van loting, waarbij teams geplaatst worden volgens de Uitvoeringsregeling Plaatsing GNSK 2024 en indien mogelijk teams van eenzelfde OSSO/stad worden verdeeld over verschillende poules. De tenniscommissie beslist voor de loting hoeveel teams per poule zich kwalificeren voor het finaleschema dat door middel van een knock-outsysteem wordt gespeeld.



7. Een teamwedstrijd bestaat uit 3 wedstrijden die in deze volgorde worden gespeeld: 2^e enkelspel, 1^e enkelspel en 1 dubbelspel. De teamcaptain is verplicht in het enkelspel de spelers in volgorde van afnemende speelsterkte op te stellen. Spelers met dezelfde speelsterkte kunnen in volgorde naar keuze worden opgesteld. Uiterlijk tot 15 minuten vóór aanvang van het dubbelspel kan de teamcaptain de dubbelopstelling wijzigen bij de tenniscommissie.

8. Mocht een team onvoldoende speelgerechtigde spelers hebben, dan worden de wedstrijden gespeeld waarvoor wel speelgerechtigde spelers beschikbaar zijn. Indien er slechts 1 enkelspel gespeeld kan worden, dan dient het sterkste enkelspel ingevuld te worden en het tweede enkelspel opgegeven te worden. De uitslag van een opgegeven wedstrijd is 6-0 6-0 in het voordeel van het andere team.

9. Wedstrijden worden gespeeld om twee gewonnen sets. Tot aan de finale bestaat een eventuele derde set uit een wedstrijd tiebreak (10 punten). De uitslag wordt dan zo dat degene die gewonnen heeft een derde set heeft gespeeld en die met 7-6 gewonnen heeft. In de finale is de 3e set een tiebreakset waarbij er bij 6-6 een tiebreak wordt gespeeld. De tenniscommissie mag van voorgaande afwijken indien zij dit nodig acht.

10. De maximale inspeeltijd is 5 minuten.

11. Voor iedere gewonnen wedstrijd, ontvangt het team één winstpunt. De eindstand van de poule wordt bepaald op basis van het aantal winstpunten dat een team behaald heeft. De eerste plaats wordt behaald door het team dat alle teamwedstrijden heeft gewonnen.

12. Wanneer in een poule twee of meerdere teams met een gelijk aantal punten eindigen, dan wordt de onderlinge volgorde als volgt bepaald:

- I. Onderling resultaat (alleen als twee teams gelijk eindigen);
- II. Setsaldo (aantal sets voor minus aantal sets tegen);
- III. Gamesaldo (aantal games voor minus aantal games tegen);
- IV. Aantal behaalde sets;
- V. Aantal behaalde games.

13. Teams die in de knock-outfase een teamwedstrijd opgeven, worden uitgesloten van deelname aan de wedstrijd om de derde plek. Een teamwedstrijd wordt als opgegeven beschouwd als minimaal 2 wedstrijden zijn opgegeven



14. De in het team opgestelde speler(s) dient/dienen op het in het wedstrijdschema aangegeven tijdstip speelklaar te zijn. Indien dit niet het geval is, verliest hij/zij de wedstrijd. De uitslag is dan 6-0 6-0 in het voordeel van de aanwezige speler(s).

15. Door de organisatie worden per wedstrijd gasgevulde tennisballen ter beschikking gesteld. Deze ballen dienen na de wedstrijd weer bij de tenniscommissie ingeleverd te worden.

Slotbepalingen

16. Spelers dienen gepaste tenniskleding te dragen en schoenen te dragen die geschikt zijn om op te tennissen. De ondergrond is kunstgras

17. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor ongevallen of schade aan derden vóór, tijdens of na de wedstrijd. Deelname geschiedt op eigen risico.

18. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor diefstal vóór, tijdens of na de competitie.

19. Voor zover in bovenstaande punten geen uitzondering wordt gemaakt, zijn de [reglementen van de KNLTB](#) van kracht.

20. In alle gevallen behoudt de tenniscommissie zich het recht voor om een bindende beslissing te nemen.

Regulations Tennis

GNSK 2025

Team composition and eligibility

1. A maximum of two men's and two women's teams can be registered per Umbrella Student Sports Organisation (hereinafter: OSSO)/city. A team consists of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 players. The first registered team per OSSO/city is always entitled to participate. Depending on the number of registered teams, it will be decided whether the second team can participate. If there are too many second teams for the remaining places, participation will be based on the order of registration.



2. The registered participants of an OSSO/city may only consist of students who meet the conditions as stated in chapter 1 of the SSN event regulations. In the event of violation of this rule, the team will lose all matches. If an ineligible participant participates in the GNSK, a fine of €200 will be charged to the OSSO/representative organisation in the city for which the participant is playing.

3. When registering, the official personal ranking or playing strength according to the KNLTB (if available) must be indicated (playing strength indicates the level of a player, with 1 being the highest and 9 the lowest).

4. The team line-up must be submitted to the tennis commission 15 minutes before the start of each team match. Should an OSSO/city send two participating teams, no players may be substituted or play for the other team. Should this happen, article 2 applies.

5. The winner of the GNSK tennis tournament 2025 qualifies for the European Universities Championships (EUC) in 2026.

Match provisions

6. The preliminary rounds consist of pools. The pool division is based on a draw, whereby teams are placed according to the Implementation Regulation Placement GNSK 2024 and, if possible, teams from the same OSSO/city are divided into different pools. The tennis committee decides before the draw how many teams per pool qualify for the final schedule that is played by means of a knock-out system.

7. A team match consists of 3 matches that are played in the following order: 2nd singles, 1st singles and 1 doubles. The team captain is obliged to line up the players in order of decreasing playing strength in the singles. Players with the same playing strength can be lined up in any order of their choice. The team captain can change the doubles line-up with the tennis committee up to 15 minutes before the start of the doubles match.

8. If a team does not have enough eligible players, the matches for which eligible players are available will be played. If only 1 singles can be played, then the strongest singles must be filled in and the second singles must be given up. The result of a given match is 6-0 6-0 in favor of the other team.



9. Matches are played for two sets won. Up to the final, a possible third set consists of a match tiebreak (10 points). The result is then such that the winner has played a third set and won it 7-6. In the final, the 3rd set is a tiebreak set, with a tiebreak being played at 6-6. The tennis committee may deviate from the above if it deems this necessary.

10. The maximum warm-up time is 5 minutes.

11. For each match won, the team receives one winning point. The final ranking of the pool is determined on the basis of the number of winning points a team has achieved. First place is achieved by the team that has won all team matches.

12. If two or more teams in a pool end up with the same number of points, the mutual order will be determined as follows:

I. Mutual result (only if two teams end up with the same number of points);

II. Set balance (number of sets for minus number of sets against);

III. Game balance (number of games for minus number of games against);

IV. Number of sets won;

V. Number of games won.

13. Teams that forfeit a team match in the knockout phase will be excluded from participating in the match for third place. A team match will be considered forfeited if at least 2 matches have been forfeited.

14. The player(s) selected in the team must be ready to play at the time indicated in the match schedule. If this is not the case, he/she will lose the match. The score will then be 6-0 6-0 in favour of the player(s) present.

15. The organisation will provide gas-filled tennis balls for each match. These balls must be returned to the tennis committee after the match.

Closing provisions

16. Players must wear appropriate tennis clothing and shoes that are suitable for playing tennis. The surface is artificial grass

17. The organization is not responsible for accidents or damage to third parties before, during or after the match. Participation is at your own risk.

18. The organization is not responsible for theft before, during or after the competition.





19. Unless an exception is made in the above points, the regulations of the KNLTB apply.

20. In all cases, the tennis committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
