Timetable

On Friday, matches start at 6.30pm. The hall will be available for practice from 6.10pm, and the matches will finish no later than 10.20pm.

On Saturday, the matches will start at 9.00 am, the hall will be available from 8.40 for practice and the matches will finish no later than 7.30 pm on Saturday.

On Sunday, matches will start at 9.20am, the hall will be available for practice from 9.00am. Matches on Sunday will finish no later than 5.30pm.

The awards ceremony of the volleyball tournaments will take place on Sunday around 5.30pm in, right after the finals. The award ceremony of the city ranking will take place on Sunday at 18:00 at the Radboud Sports Centre.

Match schedules

The match schedules can be found in the GNSK 2025 app in the section match schedules. Instructions and explanations about the app can be found below.





The group stage of the men's team tournament is played in 3 pools of 4 or 5 teams. The women's team tournament group stage is played in 2 pools of 4 or 5 teams

The men's team tournament is played in a group stage. The winners (1st, 2nd and best numbers 3) will advance to the knockout phase, which will be played from the ¼ finals onwards. All matches will be played with a best of 3 result. Only the final will be played with a best of 4/5

The women's tournament will be played in a group stage. The winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place from the pool) will play the semi-finals. The winners from this go to the final. The numbers 3 and 4 out of the group stage will play the losers' semi-final followed by the final.

Volleyball related issues

It is important to read through the regulations (*see at the very end of this playbook*) for all participants and team officials.

Hereby some rules highlighted for the volleyball tournament:

- The team list should be given to the volleyball committee before the start of each match. The use of line-up sheets is mandatory.
- The 'Nevobo | Eredivisie Game Rules' of the Nevobo apply to this tournament.
- Match shirts must be numbered in accordance with Nevobo regulations. The same applies to the colour scheme of the libero shirt.
- Match balls and play-in balls will be provided by the volleyball committee.
- Teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the match schedule. If the team is not present at the specified time, the team will lose the match.
- The pool phase will be played with matches according to a best-of-three sets system, with any third set being played in accordance with the rules of play applicable to a regular fifth set.
- During the men's and women's finals, matches will be played according to a best-of-five. sets system. Here, if a team is leading 3-0, the match is over.



Qualification European Universities Championships

The winners of the GNSK 2025 volleyball team tournament will qualify for the 2026 European Universities Championships (EUC).

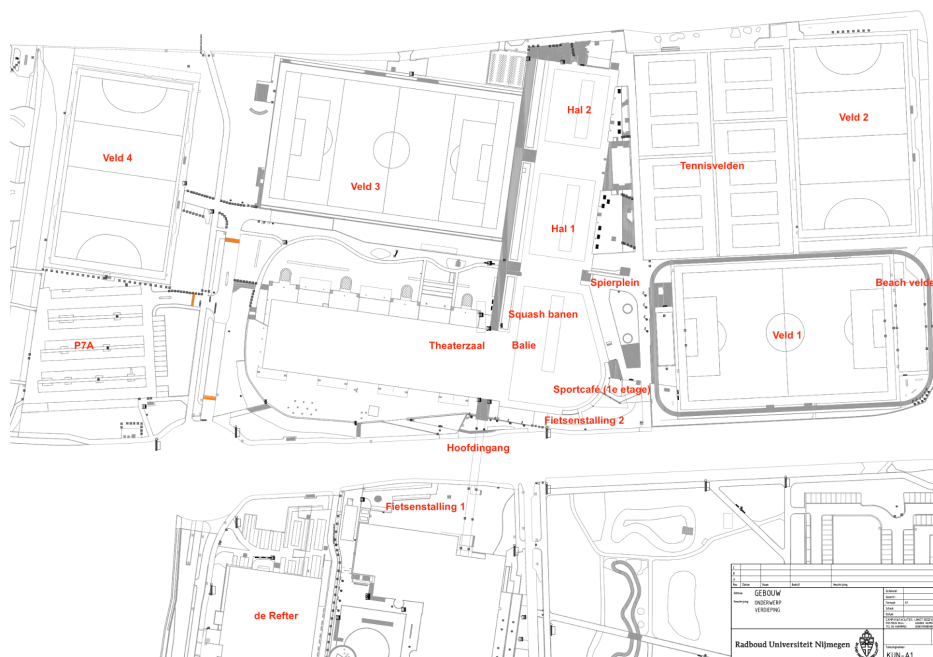

Volleyball will be played on Saturday and Sunday at *De Boog*. The Address is: **Dick Boerrigterplein 4, 6663 RC Nijmegen**

Shuttle bus:

- The shuttle bus runs on Saturday in the morning at 7:30 AM, 8:20 AM and 9:10 AM to the venue and returns in the afternoon at 18:20 PM, 19:10 PM and 20:00 PM to the Radboud Sports Centre.

Matches will be played on 4 courts in Hall 2 of the Radboud Sports Centre and on 4 courts at *De Boog*.

Registration GNSK 2024

You must be able to provide the following documents before applying:

- Valid certificate of registration from the educational institution, or certificate of graduation (*Only required for participants, not for team officials*)
- Valid accreditation card on the GNSK 2025 app (*see below GNSK 2025 app*)
- Valid passport, ID card or driving license

After this is done, participants and team officials can go to the competition venue with a valid accreditation.

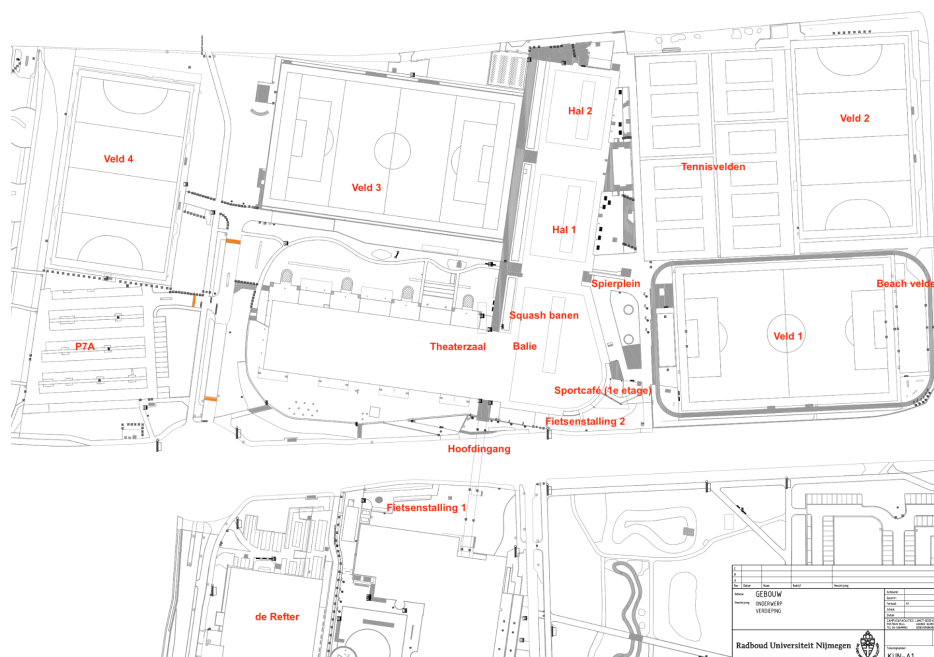

GNSK 2025 app

Catering

Breakfast

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with breakfast. The breakfast buffet is provided at *De Refter*

(Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards. Breakfast is served from 6:30 to 9:00 AM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

The breakfast includes:

- Bread: Whole wheat bread / White bread
- Toppings: Cheese / Chicken breast / Strawberry jam / Chocolate sprinkles / Boiled egg
- Other: Mini donut / Hangop (strained yogurt) / Muesli / Fruit
- Drinks: Coffee / Tea / Orange juice

Lunch

During the weekend, participants and team officials are responsible for arranging their own lunch. Various food stalls will be available at the Radboud Sports Centre, and you can also visit *The Yard*, the sports café located inside the centre.

Dinner

Dinner on Friday and Saturday is only available to participants, team officials, and volunteers who have booked the camping package with dinner. Dinner is provided at *De Refter* (Erasmusplein 3). Each guest may visit the buffet once. We kindly ask everyone to clean up their leftovers and waste afterwards.

Dinner is served from 5:00 to 8:00 PM. Specific time slots will be announced later.

Meals are served vegetarian by default. Please indicate any dietary requirements when registering.

- Friday dinner: Pasta Bolognese with Italian salad and ciabatta
- Saturday dinner: Rice with chicken curry and cucumber salad





Campsite

Accommodation is provided at the Radboud Sportcentrum in the sports halls and at a campsite located at Sportpark D'Almarasweg.

Sleeping facilities are only available to those who indicated this during their registration for GNSK 2025. Participants will either sleep in the indoor

sports halls or camp on a grass field using their own tents.

Those staying in the sports halls must bring their own sleeping gear (including mat or air mattress, blanket, and pillow).

Those camping outdoors must bring their own tents and full sleeping equipment. It's important to bring a tent appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents for too few people may be refused by the organization. If unsure, please consult the GNSK organization in advance.

We will do our best to provide sufficient power outlets and lighting at the campsite, but please note that these may be limited. We recommend bringing a flashlight and an extra power bank for added comfort.

The Radboud Centrum will be accessible at night, and the campsite will have security present 24/7.

Camping Rules

These rules are in place to ensure a pleasant and safe weekend for everyone. The organization and security staff reserve the right to remove anyone who does not comply with these regulations. You must follow the instructions of security staff, the organization, and volunteers at all times.

1. The general terms and conditions of GNSK 2025 apply to the campsite.
2. Visitors are only allowed on the campsite upon showing their accreditation in the GNSK 2025 App after registering at the registration desk in the Radboud Sports Centre.
3. Camp only in the designated areas.
4. Your tent must be appropriately sized for the number of people sleeping in it. Oversized tents may be refused.
5. Caravans, campers, and folding trailers are not allowed.



6. Passenger vehicles are not allowed on the campsite. These can be parked for a fee around the campus.
7. The campsite opens on Friday at 4:00 PM. Tents must be removed by Sunday, June 22, no later than 6:00 PM.
8. Arrival at the campsite is possible until Saturday, June 21, at 8:00 PM. Upon first arrival, report to a volunteer who will assign your camping spot.
9. A certified emergency responder (BHV'er) will be present from 8:00 PM to 8:00 AM in the tent next to the campsite.
10. Security and/or volunteers will monitor the campsite throughout the weekend. In case of emergencies, contact them or the central information desk at the Radboud Sports Centre.
11. Leaving personal items is at your own risk. The organization is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.
12. Sufficient toilet facilities are available next to the campsite. Keep them clean and tidy for the next user.
13. Power supply at the campsite is limited.
14. Open flames, including BBQs and gas cylinders, are prohibited. Cooking is not allowed due to fire safety.
15. Waste must be disposed of in the designated bins.
16. Respect the sleep of others. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Sound systems are not allowed during this time.
17. Pets are not allowed on the campsite.
18. Commercial activity, advertising, or distributing publications near the entrances or on the campsite is only allowed with prior written permission from the organization.
19. You may bring and consume your own food and drinks on the campsite, but all waste must be cleaned up.
20. Alcohol consumption is allowed, but only in cans or plastic containers.
21. Strong alcoholic beverages and any form of drugs are strictly prohibited.
22. Glass is not allowed on the campsite for safety reasons. Bags will be checked upon entry.
23. Smoking is only allowed in the designated areas next to the campsite, not on the campsite itself.





24. Upon departure on Sunday, security or volunteers may check your camping spot. You may be asked to clean up any remaining waste.

Wedstrijdreglementen (NL en ENG)

Wedstrijdreglement Volleybal GNSK 2025

Teamsamenstelling en speelgerechtigdheid

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (hierna: OSSO)/stad kunnen maximaal twee heren- en twee damesteams ingeschreven worden. Een team bestaat uit minimaal 6 en maximaal 12 spelers. Het eerste ingeschreven team per OSSO/stad heeft altijd recht om mee te doen. Afhankelijk van het aantal ingeschreven teams wordt besloten of het tweede team mee kan doen. Mochten er te veel tweede teams zijn voor de overgebleven plekken, gaat deelname op basis van volgorde van inschrijving.

2. De ingeschreven deelnemers van een OSSO/stad mogen uitsluitend bestaan uit studenten die voldoen aan de voorwaarden als gesteld in hoofdstuk 1 van het evenementenreglement van SSN. Bij overtreding van deze regel verliest het team alle wedstrijden. Als er een ongerechtigde deelnemer meedoet aan het GNSK, wordt er een boete van €200,- in rekening gebracht bij de OSSO/vertegenwoordigende organisatie in de stad voor welke die deelnemer uitkomt.

3. De teamopgave dient voor aanvang van iedere wedstrijd doorgegeven te worden aan de volleybalcommissie. Mocht een OSSO/stad twee deelnemende teams sturen, dan mogen er geen spelers gewisseld worden of bij het andere team meespelen. Mocht dit wel gebeuren, dan geldt artikel 2.

4. De winnaar van het volleybaltoernooi van het GNSK 2025 kwalificeert zich voor de European Universities Championships in 2026

Wedstrijdbepalingen

5. Op dit toernooi zijn de "[Spelregels indoor 12 juni 2024](#)" van de Nevobo van toepassing. Hierin worden de spelregels geldende voor de Eredivisie aangehouden

6. Wedstrijdshirts dienen genummerd te zijn conform Nevobo reglementen. Hetzelfde geldt voor de kleurstelling van het liberoshirt.

7. Het eerst genoemde team in het wedstrijdschema is het thuisspelende team.



8. Het streven is om voor iedere wedstrijd Nevobo scheidsrechters te regelen. Mocht dit niet lukken dan dienen niet-spelende teams, volgens het wedstrijdschema, spelers aan te dragen om te fluiten bij wedstrijden.
9. Het streven is om voor zoveel mogelijk wedstrijden tellers te regelen. Mocht dit niet lukken, dan dient het thuisspelende team vervangende tellers te regelen.
10. Er wordt gespeeld met officieel goedgekeurde wedstrijdballen. De wedstrijdballen en inspeelballen worden verstrekt door de volleybalcommissie.
11. Voorafgaand aan een wedstrijd hebben teams recht op minstens 10 minuten warming-up aan het net.
12. Het gebruik van opstellingsbriefjes is verplicht, deze dienen geregeld te worden door de teams zelf
13. De teams dienen op het in het wedstrijdschema aangegeven tijdstip aanwezig en speelklaar te zijn. Indien het team niet aanwezig is op het opgegeven tijdstip, dan verliest het team de wedstrijd. De uitslag is dan 2-0 (25-0, 25-0) in het voordeel van het aanwezige team (of 3-0 in het geval van best-of-five).
14. De voorrondes bestaan uit poules. De poule-indeling geschiedt op basis van loting, waarbij teams geplaatst worden volgens de Uitvoeringsregeling Plaatsing GNSK 2025 en indien mogelijk teams van eenzelfde OSSO/stad worden verdeeld over verschillende poules. De volleybalcommissie beslist voor de loting hoeveel teams per poule zich kwalificeren voor het finaleschema dat door middel van een knock-outsysteem wordt gespeeld.
15. De poulefase wordt gespeeld met wedstrijden volgens een best-of-three setsysteem, waarbij een eventuele derde set wordt gespeeld conform de spelregels die gelden voor een reguliere vijfde set.
16. Een met 2-0 gewonnen wedstrijd is 3 wedstrijdpunten waard, een met 2-1 gewonnen wedstrijd levert 2 wedstrijdpunten op voor het winnende team en 1 wedstrijdpunt voor het verliezende team.
17. De eindstand van de poule wordt bepaald op basis van het aantal wedstrijdpunten dat een team behaald heeft.



18. Bij een gelijk aantal wedstrijdpunten in een poule beslist achtereenvolgens:

- I. Het aantal wedstrijdpunten in de onderlinge wedstrijd(en);
- II. Het quotiënt van het aantal sets voor en tegen in de/alle onderlinge wedstrijd(en);
- III. Het quotiënt van het aantal punten voor en tegen in de/alle onderlinge wedstrijd(en);
- IV. Het quotiënt van het aantal behaalde wedstrijdpunten voor en tegen in alle gespeelde wedstrijden;
- V. Het quotiënt van het aantal sets voor en tegen in alle gespeelde wedstrijden;
- VI. Het quotiënt van het aantal punten voor en tegen in alle gespeelde wedstrijden;
- VII. Is het resultaat hierna nog gelijk, dan wordt een beslissende set gespeeld, conform de spelregels die gelden voor een vijfde set.

19. De knock-outfase wordt tot de finale eveneens volgens een best-of-three setsysteem gespeeld, waarbij een eventuele derde set wordt gespeeld conform de spelregels die gelden voor een reguliere vijfde set. De volleybalcommissie kan bepalen om de vervolgronde en halve finale alsnog in een best-of-five setsysteem te spelen indien zij dit nodig acht.

20. De finale wordt volgens een best-of-five setsysteem gespeeld. De volleybalcommissie kan besluiten om de finale alsnog in een best-of-three setsysteem te spelen indien zij dit nodig acht.

Slotbepalingen

21. Protesten betreffende scheidsrechterlijke beslissingen zijn niet mogelijk.

22. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor ongevallen of schade aan derden vóór, tijdens of na de wedstrijd. Deelname geschiedt op eigen risico.

23. De organisatie draagt geen verantwoordelijkheid voor diefstal vóór, tijdens of na de competitie.

24. In geval van geschillen beslist de volleybalcommissie, waarbij zoveel mogelijk de reglementen, richtlijnen en procedures van de Nevobo worden gevolgd zoals die van toepassing zijn op de Eredivisie, tenzij deze in strijd zijn met hetgeen bepaald is in dit document.

25. In alle gevallen behoudt de volleybalcommissie zich het recht voor om een bindende beslissing te nemen.



GNSK 2025

Team composition and eligibility to play

1. Per Overkoepelende Studenten Sport Organisatie (hereinafter: OSSO)/city, a maximum of two men's and two women's teams can be registered. A team consists of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12 players. The first registered team per OSSO/city is always entitled to participate. Depending on the number of teams registered, it will be decided whether the second team can participate. Should there be too many second teams for the remaining places, participation will be in order of registration.
2. The registered participants of an OSSO/city may only consist of students who meet the conditions as stated in chapter 1 of SSN's event regulations. If this rule is violated, the team loses all competitions. If an unauthorised participant competes in the GNSK, a fine of €200 will be charged to the OSSO/representing organisation in the city for which that participant competes.
3. The team statement must be passed to the volleyball committee. Should an OSSO/city send two participating teams, no players may be substituted or join the other team. Should this happen, then Article 2 will be applied.
4. The winner of the volleyball tournament of the GNSK 2025 qualifies for the European Universities Championships in 2026

Match provisions

5. This tournament is subject to the Nevobo's "[Spelregels indoor 12 juni 2024](#)". Herein the rules of the game valid for the Eredivisie are maintained.
6. Match shirts must be numbered in accordance with Nevobo regulations. The same applies to the colour scheme of the libero shirt.
7. The first named team in the competition schedule is the home team.
8. The aim is to arrange Nevobo referees for every match. Should this not succeed, non-playing teams should, according to the match schedule, nominate players to whistle at matches.
9. The aim is to arrange counters for as many matches as possible. Should this not be possible, the home team should arrange for substitute counters.
10. Officially approved match balls will be used. Match balls and play-in balls will be provided by the volleyball commission.



11. Prior to a match, teams are entitled to at least 10 minutes of warm-up at the net.
12. The use of line-up sheets is compulsory, to be arranged by the teams themselves.
13. Teams must be present and ready to play at the time indicated in the match schedule. If the team is not present at the specified time, the team loses the match. The result is then 2-0 (25-0, 25-0) in favour of the team present (or 3-0 in the case of best-of-five).
14. The preliminary rounds will consist of poules. The poule allocation will be based on a draw, with teams being placed according to the GNSK 2025 Placement Implementation Regulations and, if possible, teams from the same OSSO/city will be divided between different poules. Before the draw, the Volleyball Committee will decide how many teams in each poule will qualify for the finals which will be played through a knockout system.
15. The poule phase will be played with matches according to a best-of-three set system, with any third set being played in accordance with the rules of play applicable to a regular fifth set.
16. A match won 2-0 is worth 3 match points, a match won 2-1 results in 2 match points for the winning team and 1 match point for the losing team.
17. The final ranking of the poule will be determined on the basis of the number of match points gained by a team.
18. In the event of an equal number of match points in a poule, successively:
 - I. The number of match points in the match(s) between them;
 - II. The quotient of the number of sets for and against in the mutual match(s);
 - III. The quotient of the number of points for and against in the/all mutual match(s);
 - IV. The quotient of the number of match points achieved for and against in all matches played
matches;
 - V. The quotient of the number of sets for and against in all matches played;
 - VI. The quotient of the number of points for and against in all matches played;
 - VII. If the result is still tied after this, a deciding set is played, in accordance with the rules of the game that apply to a fifth set.



19. Until the final, the knock-out phase is also played according to a best-of-three set system, with a possible third set being played in accordance with the rules of play applicable to a regular fifth set. The volleyball committee may decide to play the follow-up round and semi-final in a best-of-five set system if it deems it necessary.

20. The final shall be played according to a best-of-five set system. The volleyball committee may decide to play the final in a best-of-three set system if it deems it necessary.

Closing provisions

21. Protests concerning refereeing decisions are not possible.

22. The organisation bears no responsibility for accidents or damage to third parties before, during or after the competition. Participation is at your own risk.

23. The organisation bears no responsibility for theft before, during or after the competition.

24. In case of disputes, the volleyball committee will decide, following as much as possible the regulations, guidelines and procedures of the Nevobo as they apply to the Premier League, unless they conflict with what is stipulated in this document.

25. In all cases, the volleyball committee reserves the right to make a binding decision.
